Dear Members of the Board:

The Rudolph F. Monte Foundation is once again gearing up to dazzle us with an amazing fireworks display. The proceeds of this event provide funding for school projects throughout Santa Cruz County. This year the event is scheduled on October 9 at Seacliff State Beach. The Public Works Department is once again prepared to assist the Foundation, at the Board's direction, by providing two generators, eight distribution boxes, and two light towers.

This year's attendance is expected to reach a record high and the equipment will greatly assist the logistics of the event. The Rudolph F. Monte Foundation has agreed to the terms and conditions as established by the Public Works Department in the attached agreement.

The Monte Foundation, in collaboration with the Department of Public Works, Sheriff's Department and the California Highway Patrol, has created a coordinated list of suggested appropriate road closures to address traffic flow issues. Attached is the resolution supporting the show and the requested road closures. Therefore, I recommend that the Board take the following actions:




