SHERIFF'S APTOS COMMUNITY SERVICE CENTER

Dear Members of the Board:

The Sheriff's Office has continued the development and operation of Four Sheriff's Community Centers in the un-incorporated areas of Santa Cruz County. The Aptos Community Service Center was first established in April 1996. Several civilian volunteers have been trained and their roles expanded in making our communities a safer place to live and work. The volunteers under the supervision of Sgt. Joe Hemingway have continued to provide a variety of services to the Aptos and surrounding communities from our office located at 19 D Rancho Del Mar, Aptos. Sgt. Hemingway has continued to provide a single point of contact for the Sheriff's Office from this location.

The accessibility and convenience of the Sheriff's Office storefront operation at 19 D Rancho Del Mar has been well received by both the residents and the business community of Aptos. Our walk-in clients and calls for service continue to increase from previous years. Our current lease agreement is scheduled to terminate October 1, 1999. We have an opportunity to continue the current lease agreement for a period of three years with a monthly increase of \$200 a month for a total monthly cost of \$1200 which includes the cost of utilities and refuse removal. This monthly increase can be accommodated through existing Sheriff's Office appropriations. A copy of the lease agreement is currently on file with the Clerk of the Board .

We are looking forward to continuing to provide services at this location to Aptos residents and businesses.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board:

- 1. Approve the attached third addendum to an existing lease agreement between the Sheriff's Office and James Fenton Co. Inc. for the Sheriff's Aptos Community Center, 19 D Rancho Del Mar. to extend the lease for three years beginning October 1, 1999 through September 30, 2002 at a additional cost of \$200 per month for a monthly cost of \$1200.
- 2. AUTHORIZE the Sheriff-Coroner to sign and execute the lease agreement.

THIRD ADDENDUM TO LEASE BETWEEN JAMES FENTON CO., INC. AND COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ/SHERIFF CORONER OFFICE

The lease by and between James Fenton Co., Inc. (Owner) and the County of Santa Cruz (Tenant) dated October 1, 1996 is hereby amended in the following particulars. All other provisions shall remain unchanged.
