Re: RECOMMENDATION OF AWARD FOR PLANTING AND IRRIGATION AT POLO GROUNDS COUNTY PARK #98C 1-028

Members of the Board:

At the August 10, 1999 Board meeting, bids were scheduled to be received for the Planting and Irrigation at Polo Grounds County Park Project; however, no bids were received at that time for the above referenced project.

In accordance with Section 20 150.9 of the Public Contract Code, when a project is bid and no bids are received, the County may have the project completed without re-advertising for bids in the manner prescribed by this article.

The County solicited written proposals from three Landscape Contractors that attended the prebid walk through and expressed the greatest interest in performing the work. There have been no changes to the Plans or Specifications which were publicly bid, with the exception that the anticipated construction start date will be January 1, 2000. This change was made in response to comments from potential bidders who indicated they believed the project could be done within the amount of the engineers estimate; however, current commitments prevented them from taking on additional work at that point in time.

The proposals received were reviewed by Parks, Open Spaces and Cultural Services and General Services and we believe that the lowest bidder, Hastings Landscape Conservation Services with a bid of \$72,984 can accomplish the work to the County's satisfaction. A bid re-cap Sheet is attached showing proposals received.

Sufficient funds are available in the Plant Structures and Improvements-Parks, Index 192140, Sub Object 6610, including a ten (10) per cent contingency.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board:

- 1. Award a contract to Hastings Landscape Conservation Services in the amount of \$72,984 for the Planting and Irrigation at Polo Grounds County Park; and
- 2. Authorize the General Services Director to notify the contractor and sign the contract agreements and associated documents on behalf of your Board; and
- 3. Authorize the Director of Parks, Open Space & Cultural Services to approve change orders and appropriate \$7,298.40 in addition to the contract amount to cover change order expenditures, as required.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of said County has awarded a Contract to Contractor for performing the work hereinafter mentioned in accordance with the sealed proposal of said Contractor.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed as follows:

- 1. Scope of Work. Contractor shall perform all the work and furnish all the labor, materials, equipment, and all utility and transportation services required to complete all of the work for PLANTING & IRRIGATION AT POLO GROUNDS COUNTY PARK in Santa Cruz County, in accordance with the Notice to Bidders, Specifications and Plans, Special Provisions, and Bidder's Proposal; the items and quantities of which are more particularly set forth in Contractor's Proposal, therefor, on file in the Office of the County Clerk.
- 2. <u>Time for Performance</u>. The Contractor shall begin the work within <u>ten (10) calendar</u> days after receiving the "Notice to Proceed," and shall diligently prosecute the same to completion before the expiration of <u>sixty (60)</u> calendar days from the date of said "Notice to Proceed."
- 3. Independent Contractor Status. CONTRACTOR and COUNTY have reviewed and considered the principal test and secondary factors below and agree that CONTRACTOR is an independent contractor and not an employee of COUNTY. CONTRACTOR is responsible for all insurance (workers compensation, unemployment, etc.) and all payroll related taxes. CONTRACTOR is not entitled to any employee benefits. COUNTY agrees that CONTRACTOR shall have the right to control the manner and means of accomplishing the result contracted for herein.

<u>Principal Test.</u> The CONTRACTOR rather than COUNTY has the right to control the manner and means of accomplishing the result contracted for.

Secondary Factors. (a) The extent of control which, by agreement, COUNTY may exercise over the details of the work is slight rather than substantial; (b) CONTRACTOR is engaged in a distinct occupation or business; (c) In the locality, the work to be done by CONTRACTOR is usually done by a specialist without supervision, rather than under the direction of an employer; (d) The skill required in the particular occupation is substantial rather than slight; (e) The CONTRACTOR rather than the COUNTY supplies the instrumentalities, tools and workplace; (f) The length of time for which CONTRACTOR is engaged is of limited duration rather than indefinite; (g) The method of payment of CONTRACTOR is by the job rather than by the time; (h) The work is part of a special or permissive activity, program, or project, rather than part of the regular business of COUNTY; (i) CONTRACTOR and COUNTY believe they are creating an independent contractor relationship rather than an employer-employee relationship; and (j) The COUNTY conducts public business.

It is recognized that it is not necessary that all secondary factors support creation of an independent contractor relationship, but rather that overall there are significant secondary factors which indicate that CONTRACTOR is an independent contractor.

- 4. <u>Component Parts</u>. This Contract shall consist of the following documents, each of which is on file with the Santa Cruz County Clerk of the Board, and all of which are incorporated herein, and made a part hereof by reference thereto:
 - a. This Agreement and Guarantees
 - b. Notice to Bidders, inviting sealed proposals
 - C. Specifications entitled: PLANTING AND IRRIGATION AT POLO GROUNDS COUNTY PARK
 - d. Plans entitled: PLANTING AND IRRIGATION AT POLO GROUNDS COUNTY PARK
 - e. Bidder's Bond
 - f. Accepted Proposal
 - g. Performance Bond
 - h. Payment Bond
 - i. Certificate of Worker's Compensation Insurance
 - j. Certificate of General Liability Insurance
 - k. Certificate of Auto Liability Insurance
- 5. County shall pay and Contractor shall accept, in full consideration for the performance of the Contract, subject to additions and deductions as provided therein, the sum of \$ _______
- 6. Pursuant to County Code Section 2.37.107, any bid, proposal, or other response to a solicitation for bid or proposal which proposes or calls for the use of any tropical hardwood or wood product in performance of the contract shall be deemed nonresponsive. The contractor shall not

provide any items in performance of this contract which are tropical hardwoods or tropical hardwood products. The County of Santa Cruz urges companies not to import, purchase, obtain, or use for any purpose, any tropical hardwood or tropical hardwood product. In the event any bidder or contractor fails to comply in good faith with any of the provisions of County Code Section 2.37.107, the bidder or contractor shall be liable for liquidated damages in an amount equal to the bidder's or contractor's net profit under the contract, Or five (5) percent of the total amount of the contract dollars, whichever is greater. The contractor acknowledges and agrees that the liquidated damages assessed shall be payable to the County upon demand and may be set off against any monies due to the bidder or contractor from any contract with the County.

7. Nondiscrimination Clause.

The CONTRACTOR shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, physical or mental disability, medical condition (cancer related), marital status, sexual orientation, age (over 18), veteran status, gender, pregnancy, or any other non-merit factor unrelated to job duties. Such action shall include, but not be limited to, the following: recruitment; advertising, layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training (including apprenticeship), employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer. The CONTRACTOR agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notice setting forth the provisions of this non-Contractors and subcontractors shall comply discrimination clause. with the provisions of the Fair Enployment and Housing Act (Government Code, Section 12900 et seg.) and the applicable regulations promulgated thereunder (California Administrative Code, Title 2, Section 7285.0 et seq). The applicable regulations of the Fair Employment and Housing Commission implementing Government Code, Section 12990, set forth in Chapter 5 of Division 4 of Title 2 of the California Administrative Code are incorporated into this contract by reference and made a part hereof as if set forth in full. Contractor and its subcontractors shall give written notice of their obligations under this clause to labor organizations with which they have a collective bargaining or other agreement.

The CONTRACTOR will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the CONTRACTOR, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, physical or mental disability, medical condition (cancer related), marital status, sexual orientation, age (over 18), veteran status, gender, pregnancy, or any other non-merit factor unrelated to job duties. Such action shall include, but not be limited to, the following: recruitment; advertising, layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training (including apprenticeship), employment, upgrading, denotion, or transfer. The CONTRACTOR agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to

employees and applicants for employment, notice setting forth the provisions of this non-discrimination clause.

The CONTRACTOR will cause the foregoing provisions to be inserted in all subcontracts for any work covered by this Agreement, provided that the foregoing provisions shall not apply to contracts or subcontracts for standard commercial supplies or raw materials.

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GUARANTY

TO THE COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ

The undersigned, as prime Contractor, guarantees the construction and installation of the following work included in this project:

PLANTING & IRRIGATION AT POLO GROUNDS COUNTY PARK

Should any of the materials or equipment prove defective, due to faulty workmanship, material furnished or methods of installation or should the work or any part thereof fail to operate properly as originally intended and in accordance with the plans and specifications, due to any of the above causes, all within one (1) year after the date on which this contract work is accepted by the County, the undersigned agrees to reinburse the County, upon demand, for County's expenses incurred in restoring said work to the condition contemplated in said project, including the cost of any such equipment or materials replaced and the cost of removing and replacing any other work necessary to make such replacement or repairs, or, upon demand by the County, to replace any such material and to repair said work completely without cost to the County so that said work will function successfully as originally contemplated. (Ordinary wear and tear and unusual abuse or neglect excepted.) Additionally, any manufacturer's warranties associated with materials to be provided as delineated therein.

The County shall have the unqualified option to make any needed replacement or repairs itself or to have such replacements or repairs done by the undersigned. In the event the County elects to have said work performed by the undersigned, the undersigned agrees that the repairs shall be made and such materials as are necessary shall be furnished and installed within a reasonable time after the receipt of demand from the County. If the undersigned shall fail or refuse to comply with his obligations under this guaranty, the County shall be entitled to all costs and expenses, including attorney's fees, reasonably incurred by reason of said failure or refusal.
