

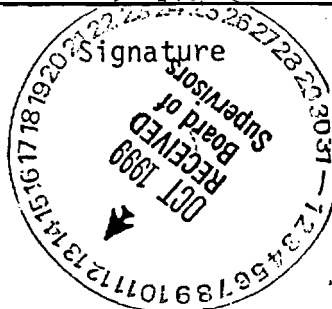

To whom it may concern:

Service on the Santa **Cruz** County Proposition 10 Commission is of great personal and professional interest to me. It is a commission to which I believe I have a great deal to offer.

I am a developmental psychologist and serve as a professor of Child Development at San Jose State University. I am also the director of the laboratory preschool on campus. My education and my "hands-on" experience with children provide a sound basis for assisting with the development of strategies for how our county will allocate its Proposition 10 **funds**.

A great deal of my research has been focused on program evaluation. Most of my projects have dealt with initiatives serving children, and many of those programs have been designed to serve ethnic minorities. I believe that with a substantial knowledge of evaluation and through personal experience conducting research I can contribute to the deliberations of the commission in a useful way. I think my background may prove especially helpful when it is time to make hard decisions about which programs will be recommended for funding.

Since the early 90s, I have served as a commissioner on the County Human Services Commission. In that role I have learned a great deal about social services in the county that are provided by public agencies and those provided by private not-for-profit organizations. I think that I have a good deal of knowledge about local efforts to improve the lot children in our community.

Finally, I think of myself as a collaborator in getting the work of a group accomplished. With regard to Prop 10 funds, I have no particular "axe" to grind, nor do I have an agenda. My goal is to help to make the experience of being a very young child in Santa Cruz County as good as can be for the largest number of children possible.
