REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AGREEMENT F2I6-9061

Dear Members of the Board:

As you know, the Human Resources Agency (HRA) contracts with the California Department of Education (CDE) to provide subsidized child care services to eligible families in Santa Cruz County, including CalWORKs Stages 2 and 3 child care services. In August your Board approved contracts for these services for the 1999-2000 fiscal year. The purpose of this letter is to request that your Board approve an additional contract for child care services which will also provide funds for child care services for families who are moving towards self-sufficiency.

Agreement F2I6-9061 provides Stage 2 child care subsidies for CalWORKs participants whose welfare to work activities and child care needs have stabilized and for those transitioning off cash grants. The additional amount available for these services through this agreement is \$65,603.

This new agreement along with the funding terms and conditions, which describe the requirements for the agreement, are on file with the Clerk of the Board. Funds were allocated for these services in the 1999-2000 Human Resources Agency budget, and therefore, no additional budgetary action is required.

The new agreement with the Department of Education, as described in this letter, will provide for essential supportive services to assist families in our community. IT IS THEREFORE RECOMMENDED that your Board adopt the Resolution certifying your Board's approval to

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accept Agreement F2I6-9061 with the California Department of Education for \$65,603 (Attachment 1), and authorize the Human Resources Agency Administrator to execute Agreement F2I6-9061 and to make subsequent minor changes thereto when appropriate and necessary.




