AMENDMENT TO CONSULTANT CONTRACT

HARO, KASUNICH AND ASSOCIATES

Members of the Board:

The Browns Valley Road Bridge, which crosses Los Corralitos Creek, is currently under engineering evaluation for the design of a new bridge. This month Public Works received the approved Categorical Exclusion determination from the California Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway Administration, indicating that the environmental studies required under the National Environmental Protection Act were approved. This level of approval is required prior to commencing final project design or right of way negotiations.

The project approval by the National Marine Fisheries Service and Federal Fish and Wildlife placed additional mitigation conditions on the bridge replacement project. The County must limit the time period that construction takes place in the stream channel to June 15 through October 15, when the steelhead are not spawning. This is because the Browns Valley Creek is registered as a migratory salmon and steelhead fishery on the endangered species list.

Last week your Board approved a contract amendment for the County's bridge design consultant, Martin and Kane, Inc., which allows them to evaluate an alternative bridge type that will address these additional mitigation conditions. Similarly, attached for your Board's review and approval is an amendment to our current independent contractor agreement with Haro, Kasunich and Associates, Inc., in the amount of \$6,820.00. This amendment provides for additional geotechnical services in conjunction with the additional design work now being performed by Martin and Kane, Inc.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

- 1. Approve the attached amendment to the independent contractor agreement with Haro, Kasunich and Associates, Inc., for engineering design services for the Browns Valley Road Bridge Replacement project for an amount not to exceed \$6,820.00.
- 2. Authorize the Director of Public Works to sign the amendment on behalf of the County.
