Re: Legal Research Contract

Dear Members of the Board:

This is to request authority to enter into a subscriber agreement for Westlaw Legal Research Services. This office has an existing contract with the West Group for Westlaw services through a modem. Due to the limited capacity of the telephone lines in the office, the modem access to the Westlaw Legal Research Services is only available on one computer in our library. Recently, the West Group has made Westlaw Legal Research Services available on the Internet at a reasonable cost. The West Group representative's proposal is to make the Westlaw Legal Research Services available on the Internet to this office on an unlimited basis for a monthly charge of \$490. This Internet access will allow each attorney to access the Westlaw Legal Research Services on their own computers. This access to the Westlaw Legal Research Services will be significantly more efficient than the current modem access which it would replace. Sufficient monies are available in the professional services account in the County Counsel budget to pay for this agreement.

IT IS THEREFORE RECOMMENDED that your Board authorize County Counsel to enter into a subscriber agreement with the West Group for Westlaw Legal Research Services on the Internet for a monthly charge of \$490.

All Library subscriptions shall include access to Westlaw.
