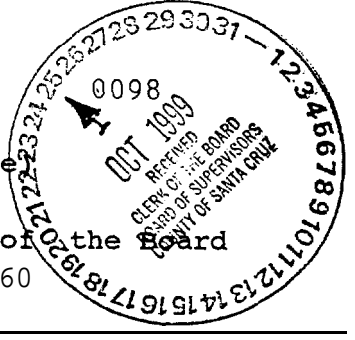

1999, when on the basis of the same set-up, the claimant was again accoted over the same bogus charge.


