SUBJECT: ROY WILSON YARD, GROUNDWATER MONITORING AND
WELL RELOCATION TO COMPLY WITH CORRECTIVE ACTION PLAN
REQUIREMENTS

Members of the Board:

On May 25, 1999, your Board approved continued funding for contracts with D&M Consulting Engineers, Inc., in order to comply with the Corrective Action Plan (CAP) requirements that were approved by the State Regional Water Quality Control Board (SRWQCB). The CAP required the destruction of the water supply well at Roy Wilson Yard in addition to drilling a new well farther away from the fuel leak area. The CAP further required continued monitoring of several area wells to monitor the potential spread of the contaminants from the leak.

The project was progressing with the preliminary design phase of the new well and destruction of the existing well; however, on October 17, 1999, as a result of our routine groundwater monitoring, low concentrations of hydrocarbon contaminants were detected in the water supply well at Roy Wilson Yard. Power to the well was shut off immediately and notification was made to all agencies currently involved. SRWQCB, as lead agency, suggested that the well be destroyed as soon as possible to prevent further contamination. In order to properly perform the necessary functions to destroy the well and drill a new well, the scope of work for the existing contract with D&M Consulting Engineers, Inc., must be expanded. The expanded scope will include remediation services such as the required well destruction and also groundwater remediation that may be necessary if subsequent sampling of the well indicates remediation may be required. It is therefore necessary to amend the related independent contractor agreement with D&M Consulting Engineers, Inc.


In order to comply with the requirements of the CAP and the SRWQCB, and to complete the well destruction and possible remediation of the groundwater, an additional \$20,000.00 will be needed.

Sufficient **funds** are available within the Department of Public Works Roads and Yards Internal Service Fund to cover the cost of the contract.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Approve the attached amendment to the original agreement with D&M Consulting Engineers, Inc., in an increased amount not to exceed \$20,000.
2. Authorize the Director of Public Works to sign the amendment to the agreement.

AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT


The parties hereto agree to amend Contract number 61321, dated August 6, 1996, by and between the COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ and D&M CONSULTING ENGINEERS, INC. in order to continue the monitoring of the natural attenuation of petroleum hydrocarbons identified in the groundwater at Roy Wilson Yard and to provide consulting services for both the water supply well installation and the destruction of the existing water supply well. Therefore Section 1, of the existing contract, is amended to add the following: Perform consulting services for well installation and well destruction and to continue monitoring the natural attenuation of the hydrocarbons at Roy Wilson Yard. Section 2, of the existing contract, is amended to add the following: Increase the amount of payment by \$ 20,000.00 and thereby making the total payment in the amount of \$ 93,700.00.

All other provisions of said contract shall remain the same.


