Unified Fee Schedule

Dear Members of the Board:

Attached are the proposed revisions to the Unified Fee Schedule from various County departments. The revisions are accompanied by fee information sheets that provide an explanation of the fee changes.

The Director of Animal Control recommends a number of changes to fee schedule. In some instances, it is recommended that the schedule be modified to change references to the Poundmaster to the Director of Animal Control. Other fees are recommended to recover the costs of various services and to align impound fees to the fines assessed for ordinance violations. These fees were considered by your Board in connection with the 1999/2000 Animal Control contract.

The Health Services Agency recommends revised Environmental Health fees related to sewage disposal systems.

The Parks, Open Space, and Cultural Services Department is adding fees for new facility rentals and programs including Valencia Hall, the Swim Center, Community Gardens, and Sports

IT IS THEREFORE RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD hold a public hearing on the proposed amendments to the Unified Fee Schedule and adopt the attached resolution revising the Unified Fee Schedule with the amended fees and charges as presented.



SECTION I - PARK AND BUILDING RULES AND REGULATIONS

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D. <u>FACILITY REGULATIONS</u> (continued)

8) Set up/Clean up

Responsibility for general set-up and clean-up of the premises shall be the responsibility of the permittee. Buildings and grounds shall be left free of debris and other refuse pertaining to said use. Cost of corrections shall be deducted from the cleaning and damage deposit. Clean-up includes storing all chairs and tables back into designated areas after the event, cleaning kitchen areas including stove and refrigerator and removing all decorations and equipment immediately following the event. The facility reserved must be restored to pre-activity conditions for a full refund of the cleaning and damage deposit.

9) Damage

- a) The user shall not injure, mar or in any way deface the facility or equipment therein; only masking tape may be used In decorations. If the facility is marred or defaced by the act or negligence of the user, employee or employees, patron, guest, or any other person using the facility while the facility is under control of the user, the user will pay to the County, on demand, such sums as the Director shall determine to be necessary to restore the facility or such equipment to its condition prior to such damage. Any deposit made by the user may be retained by the County to cover part or all of the cost of repairing damaged facilities.
- b) Deposits and Additional Charges
 The Department shall collect damage and clean-up deposits
 from users to assure that costs are associated with
 services. Deposits are refundable after inspection by
 Department personnel. Amount of deposit may be increased
 based on the potential for excessive clean-up or damage.
 c) A \$25.00 non-refundable cleaning fee may be charged to
 indoor facility users, including use by county departments,
 to cover costs associated with use.

Attached is the Planning Departments Fee Schedule effective August 24 December 7, 1999. All proposed development projects in the unincorporated County area, unless otherwise exempted, may be subject to authorizing construction or use.

This schedule also includes fees for various building and other construction permits required by the Uniform Building Code, Uniform Mechanical Code, Uniform Plumbing Code, and the National Electrical Code, as amended by Chapter 12 of the County Code.

This schedule does not include various service and capital improvement fees that may be required by agencies other than Planning, such as park dedication, roadside and roadway improvement, transportation improvement, Department of Public Works, special district, Environmental Health Department fees, and fire agency review fees, etc. A separate schedule is available which summarizes service and capital improvement fees.

Calculation of fees for discretionary reviews, permits, capital services and improvements is based upon project complexity, specific site characteristics, location, and other factors subject to various local, state and federal land use laws.

Applicants may refer to the Santa Cruz County Code, the General Plan, Local Coastal Plan, and other appropriate land use documents and maps for specific information on regulations that may apply.
