Statement of Qualifications

My enthusiasm for serving on this commission is motivated by the sincere belief that my unique blend of leadership and conflict resolution skills, and my financial and administrative talents will enable me to make a meaningful contribution to its continued success.

As a volunteer health insurance counselor and advocate I have attended two formal training sessions of four days duration, and one 2 hour in-service class per month for the past twenty months on the latest government provided health care assistance programs.

During this same period I counseled 120 persons, during sessions lasting 1 to 2 hours, and served as their advocate with government agencies, health care providers and insurance companies.

My interest is in improving programs which assist older adults to obtain medical services, provide health care and education to low income families, and promote independent living for the disabled.
