COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FOR STATE ROUTE 9 AND GLEN ARBOR ROAD - TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL AND SAFETY LIGHTING PROJECT

Members of the Board:

The State of California Department of Transportation (CALTRANS) has submitted for execution an original and four copies of an Amendment Number 1 to Cooperative Agreement (#05-CA-0036) between the County of Santa Cruz and the State of California to extend the termination date of the original Cooperative Agreement from January 1, 1999, to June 30, 200 1. The original agreement approved by your Board on June 25, 1996, approved an allocation of \$56,192 in County funding toward the installation of the traffic control signal and safety lighting at State Route 9 and lower Glen Arbor Road. CALTRANS has requested that the original and four copies of Amendment 1 to Cooperative Agreement be signed by the Chairperson of the Board of Supervisors and a Resolution authorizing the amendment be provided for each copy. After signature by the appropriate CALTRANS officials, the County will be furnished a fully executed copy of the amendment for Public Works' tiles.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

- 1. Approve the attached Amendment 1 to Cooperative Agreement between the State of California and County of Santa Cruz for the installation of a traffic control signal and safety lighting at State Route 9 and Glen Arbor Road.
- 2. Adopt the attached resolution authorizing the execution of the Amendment 1 to Cooperative Agreement.

3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to return the signed Amendment 1 to Cooperative Agreement and four copies with authorizing resolution to the State of California Department of Transportation.

WHEREAS, the County agrees to fund the electrical energy costs for the traffic control signal and safety lighting at State Route 9 and Glen Arbor Road; and

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Cruz and CALTRANS agree that the agreement should be extended to June 30, 2001, through Amendment 1 to Cooperative Agreement (#05-CA-0036).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that said Amendment 1 to Cooperative Agreement (#05-CA-0036) is hereby approved.

AMENDMENT #1 TO AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT, EFFECTIVE ON December 31, 1998, is between the STATE OF CALIFORNIA, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, referred to herein as "STATE," and

COUNTY of Santa Cruz a political subdivision of the State of California, referred to herein as "COUNTY"

RECITALS

- (1) The parties hereto entered into an AGREEMENT (Document #013533) on June 25, 1996, said AGREEMENT defining the terms and conditions of a project to install a traffic control signal and safety lighting on State Route 9 at the intersection of Glen Arbor Road (PM 8.1), in the County of Santa Cruz, referred to herein as "PROJECT".
- (2) It has been determined that PROJECT cannot be constructed prior to the termination date of said Agreement. Storm damage necessitated extensive highway repairs before PROJECT could commence.

IT IS THEREFORE MUTUALLY AGREED:

- (1) The termination date specified in Section III, Article 17 of the original Agreement shall now be June 30, 2001 instead of January 1, 1999.
- (2) The other terms and conditions of said AGREEMENT (Document #013533) shall remain in full force and effect.

(3) This AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT is hereby deemed to be a part of Document #013533.
