SUBJECT: STATE / LOCAL PARTNERSHIP GRANT APPLICATION

Dear Members of the Board:

The California Arts Council (CAC) allocates funds to one Arts Council in each County through its State/Local Partnership program to encourage cultural planning and decision making at the local level and for the development of programs to serve heretofore under-served constituents. To qualify for the State/Local Partnership, an organization is required to have developed a comprehensive Arts Plan which is currently being implemented and the organization must be designated by your Board.

The Cultural Council of Santa Cruz County, for the past nineteen years, has been designated by the Board of Supervisors as the State/Local Partner for Santa Cruz County, thereby creating an opportunity for the Cultural Council to apply for funds available under this program.

Last year the Cultural Council requested \$40,000 in CAC State/Local funds and received \$41,000 designated for general operating support.

For 1999-00, the Cultural Council is requesting \$40,000 for general operating support, the am-ount to be awarded to all the local arts agencies that meet the criterial for funding through the CAC's State/Local Partnership Program, pending the CAC's budget allocation from the State.

No financial commitment is required on the part of the County for this grant, the request for which is due to the CAC in January 2000. In the event the Cultural Council is successful in obtaining the grant, an agreement will be returned to your Board for approval of accepting the award.
