V C I, contractor for the County, damaged Pacific Bell's underground cable during a road widening project for the County. The contractor had obliterated the locate marks placed by Pacific Bell's locator. In addition, the contractor was aware of the location of our cables, having cut them on October 1 st.

DESCRIPTION & ITEMIZATION OF DAMAGE:

Two 50 pair cables were ripped in half by the contractor's backhoe.
