SUBJECT: APPLICATION FOR TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT FUNDS FOR THE ELECTRIC BIKE COMMUTER INCENTIVE PROGRAM

Members of the Board:

The Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission (SCCRTC) is requesting applications for the Transportation Development Act (TDA) Demonstration Program. The program provides annual grant funding for special one-time "demonstration" projects, or start-ups for potential longer term transportation programs. The applications are due by February 10, 2000, for the 1999/2000 fiscal year and individual agencies may apply for up to \$25,000 per project. On January 25, 2000, your Board approved a request for one other application from the Department of Public Works in the amount of \$20,000 to install crosswalk pavement lights for the Porter Street and West Walnut Street intersection.

The Department of Public Works is proposing to submit a second application in the amount of \$25,000 to provide "bridge funding" for the Electric Bike Commuter Incentive Program, This program was approved for planning purposes by the SCCRTC last summer naming Ecology Action as the lead agency for development and implementation. The SCCRTC staff have indicated the intent to sponsor the program for a Congestion Mitigation Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ) grant from the federal government in the upcoming fiscal year. In the interim, the Department of Public Works recognizes the value of implementing a "demonstration" project before the CMAQ funding process has ensued.

The Department of Public Works is proposing to act as the sponsoring public agency on behalf of Ecology Action for a TDA grant to fund a pilot project. The pilot project will consist of providing a series of incentives for residents to switch from single occupancy autos to electric

bikes for regular commuting throughout the county. Specific commute corridors will be targeted to relieve as much congestion as possible during peak travel times while continually improving the safety factor for regular bike commuters. A pilot project will allow your Board and the SCCRTC Commissioners to establish the long term value of a permanent Electric Bike Commuter Incentive Program in Santa Cruz County. The total pilot program budget is \$48,000, with \$23,000 currently recommended for funding from SCCRTC reserves. Additionally, Ecology Action will contribute \$7,500 in matching funds in the form of staff development time toward the pilot program.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors adopt the attached resolution approving the application for funds **from** the TDA Demonstration Program.
