RE: APPROVE ACCEPTANCE OF CAR SEAT FUNDING AWARD

Dear Board Members:

The Health Services Agency has received \$4,200 from the American Automobile Association (AAA)-California State Automobile Association for the purchase and distribution of child car safety seats. A resolution accepting and appropriating this unanticipated revenue is attached.

The AAA-California State Automobile Association operates a "Have a Seat" program that distributes child car safety seats to low income families through participating agencies. In 1999, the AAA contacted the Health Services Agency about taking part in this program, with a special focus on teen parents. HSA responded with a proposal to include car seats in the County's Adolescent Family Life Program (AFLP) and the Cal-Learn Program.

Together, these programs serve over 300 families each year, many of which cannot afford car seats. Additionally, HSA proposed to work with other local programs and agencies, including the Teenage Mothers Program countywide, the Migrant Head Start Program in Watsonville, and Watsonville Community Hospital. HSA requested a total of 250 car seats.

The AAA accepted HSA's proposal and initially provided 85 car seats to the County. The \$4,200 award will allow HSA to purchase and distribute approximately 160 additional car seats to complete the AAA grant. An important element of the program during distribution to clients is to teach proper installation of the car seats. According to the AAA, traffic safety experts estimate that 90 per cent of all child car safety seats are either improperly installed or need adjustment. Staff from HSA and other agencies have participated in AAA-sponsored training sessions on car seat installation and usage. This grant improves child safety in automobiles.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board:

1. Adopt the attached resolution accepting and appropriating \$4,200 in unanticipated revenue from AAA-California State Automobile Association for a child car safety seat program.

Thank you for your participation in our "Have A Seat" child car safety-seat program. I'm enclosing a check in the amount of \$4,200 for the remainder of your grant.

Chiid car safety seats can be ordered directly from the vendor. Orders for car seats must esceed \$700 per shipment. For Evenflo products, please contact Linda Galer at 877-288-0288. If you are in need of a high back booster you can contact Carol Helmenski at Graco/Century her phone number is 330-468-2000. I'm enclosing a copy of the specifications on the seats we have used in the past. Please feel free to use any vendor you feel will best meet your needs.

Traffic safety experts estimate that up to 90% of all child car safety seats are in-properly installed or need adjustment. Because of this disturbing statistic, we ask that-you agree to provide training to your clients and staff on proper safety-seat installation. If you need assistance in training your clients and staff I recommend that you call your local SafeKids Coalition. In accepting the AAA- California State Automobile Association grant in the amount of \$4,200 we ask that you agree to the following:

- 1. Agree to provide instruction to clients on proper usage of car safety seats.
- 2. Keep adequate records accounting for funds used in this grant, forwarding confirmation of funds used for car seats and related materials by 9/30/00.
- 3. Inform and receive approval from AAA-California State Automobile Association before releasing information about this grant to the press or other news media.
- 4. Inform AAA-California State Automobile Association immediately of any changes in tax exempt status under Section 501(c) (3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code.
- 5. In listing the donation in any printed material please refer to our organization as MA-California State Automobile Association.
