SUBJECT: PINECREST, COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 46 (DISTRICT 5)

Members of the Board:

During the October 1989 Loma Prieta Earthquake, County Service Area (CSA) No. 46, Pinecrest sustained damage to its service area road.

The repair project was completed and paid for using Office of Emergency Services and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) funds. Public Works has now received the retention from FEMA for the completed project. In order for this money to be available in this year's budget, we are now requesting that your Board adopt a resolution accepting unanticipated revenue.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors adopt the attached resolution accepting unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$27,717.41 from FEMA for Pinecrest, County Service Area No. 46.


