SUBJECT: SAINT FRANCIS SUBDIVISION REORGANIZATION

LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION NO. 864, PUBLIC HEARING

## Members of the Board:

At the February 15, 2000, Board meeting, your Board set March 14, 2000, as the date for the public hearing required by Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) Resolution No. 864. On December 1, 1999, LAFCO adopted this resolution authorizing proceedings to reorganize the subject property. The purpose of today's hearing is to invite public testimony regarding the proposed annexation to the Salsipuedes Sanitary District and detachment from County Service Area No. 12 (Septic Maintenance). Property owners within the subdivision initiated the reorganization of territory.

The Saint Francis Subdivision area is concurrently undergoing the assessment district process for proposed sewer improvements. The Salsipuedes Sanitary District and the Santa Cruz County Planning Department require that the area undergo annexation proceedings to be included within the Sanitation District's boundary prior to obtaining sewer service. The annexation fees have been calculated by the Salsipuedes Sanitary District staff and will be included in the assessment district costs, if the assessment district is approved at a later date.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Open the public hearing to receive all oral and written protests, objections, and evidence.

- 2. Adopt resolution ordering reorganization of territory to the Salsipuedes Sanitary District.
- 3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to forward the required data to LAFCO as specified therein.

## BEFORE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

On the motion of Supervisor duly seconded by Supervisor the following resolution is adopted:

RESOLUTION ORDERING REORGANIZATION OF TERRITORY TO THE SALSIPUEDES SANITARY DISTRICT "SAINT FRANCIS SUBDIVISION REORGANIZATION" LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION NO. 864

WHEREAS, the Santa Cruz Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of Santa Cruz adopted its Resolution No. 864, December 1, 1999, making determinations and approving the proposed annexation to the Salsipuedes Sanitary District and the detachment from County Service Area No. 12 (Septic Maintenance) of territory described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the terms and conditions of annexation as approved by the Local Agency Formation Commission are as follows: The County will provide a map, legal description, and fees to meet Local Agency Formation Commission, State Board of Equalization and Salsipuedes Sanitary District requirements upon completion of the Saint Francis Sewer Assessment District; and

WHEREAS, the reasons for this proposed annexation are to allow the property owners within the proposed Saint Francis Sewer Assessment District eligibility for sewer service if they approve the formation of the assessment district; and

WHEREAS, the regular County assessment roll is utilized by the Salsipuedes Sanitary District; and

WHEREAS, the affected territory will not be taxed for existing general bonded indebtedness of the Salsipuedes Sanitary District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors certifies that the information contained in the Negative Declaration was approved by the County of Santa Cruz Environmental Administrator on July 20, 1998; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on this reorganization was called for and held by this Board at the place and time noticed therefore on March 14, 2000, and this Board finds and determines that the value of written protests filed and not withdrawn is less than 25 percent of the registered voters residing within the territory to be annexed and less than 25 percent of the number of owners of land owning less than 25 percent of the assessed value of land within the territory.



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz that the Board of Supervisors of Santa Cruz County hereby orders the territory described in Exhibit "A" be annexed to the Salsipuedes Sanitary District and detached from County Service Area No. 12 (Septic Maintenance), and directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution with applicable fees required by Section 54902.5 of the Government Code to the executive officer of the Local Agency Formation Commission of Santa Cruz County.
