Re: Articles 3 & 4 on claim form.

Approximately March 2 I noticed one of several pot holes on Glen Canyon Rd. during the extensive rains we had during that period. However, the pot hole that caused the damage to my car kept getting larger and deeper. Since I live on Glen Canyon Rd I travel it at least 2x a day and tried avoiding this larger pothole. However on March 8 or 9 I inadvertently hit it with an extreme jarring to the front of my car. Two or thee days later (on the weekend) I noticed the temperature gauge in my car slowly increasing beyond the half way mark. On Monday March 13, I called my garage for an appointment which was made for the following day.

My chief complaint was overheating but since I was due for a service maintenance at 75,000 miles (at the time I had a little over 74,000 miles on the odometer) I decided to have that done..

It was at that time the service dept. discovered a crack in the radiator, which of course resulted in a slow leak of the coolant and overheating. I was told that many of the newer cars now have radiators with plastic tanks which are less resistant to shocks.

Therefore my claim to the County of Santa is a total of \$404.58 for the replacement of a car radiator due to the negligence of not repairing a deep pothole for a period of at least one week.

Please see claim by my wife, Lucienne Seftel for a destroyed tire caused by this same pothole.
