DATE, PLACE AND OTHER CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE OCCURRENCE OR INCIDENT WHICH GIVE RISE TO THE CLAIM ASSERTED:

On October 13, 1999 Sergeant James Hart of the Santa Cruz Sheriff's Office was present at the home of Jeff Rodrigs at 662 Sunset Drive in Capitola, California. Jeff Rodrigs suffers from Multiple Sclerosis and has been diagnosed with this condition for approximately ten years. Mr. Rodrigs has been treated by Dr. Schoenfeld for this illness and has recommended that Mr. Rodrigs use marijuana pursuant to Proposition 2 15. On the 13th, Sergeant Hart was advised by Mr. Rodrigs of his medical condition and was shown the recommendation by Dr. Schoenfeld. Sergeant Hart declared to Mr. Rodrigs that, "Dr. Schoenfeld is a quack". Thereafter, at Sergeant Hart's direction, Sergeant Hart and Capitola Police officers confiscated Mr. Rodrigs' medical marijuana.

NAMES OR NAMES OF PUBLIC EMPLOYEE(S) CAUSING INJURY, DAMAGE OR LOSS: Sergeant Hart; Deputy Steve Christensen, and others not known at this time.

AMOUNT CLAIMED AS OF THIS DATE: Claimant wants a public apology by Sergeant Hart for his slanderous comment. If no acceptable apology is forthcoming claimant requests an amount as yet unascertained but in excess of the jurisdictional limit of the superior court of the state of California for general damages, special damages, punitive exemplary or deterrent damages, and attorneys fees.
