SUBJECT: OLD SUMMIT ROAD PAVEMENT REPAIR PROJECT

Members of the Board:

The specifications and engineer's estimate for the subject project are complete and presented here for your consideration and approval. The work provides for repairing damage to Old Summit Road by applying an asphalt pavement overlay.

The engineer's estimate for this project is \$25,000, not including contingencies and administration. Sufficient **funds** are available in the 1999/2000 Road Budget to cover this expenditure.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

- 1. Approve the specifications and engineer's estimate and authorize calling for bids.
- 2. Set the bid opening for 10:45 a.m. on June 13, 2000.

3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise the attached Notice to Contractors for a ten-day period beginning May 14, 2000, in accordance with the provisions of Public Contract Code Section 20392.

Sealed proposals shall be delivered to the Director of Public Works of Santa Cruz County, Room 410, Governmental Center, no later than **10:30 a.m.**, **JUNE 13, 2000**, and at 10:45 a.m. or soon after, they will be publicly opened and read, in the Supervisors' Hearing Room, 701 Ocean Street, Santa Cruz, California, for construction on Old Summit Road in accordance with the specifications therefor, to which special reference is made, as follows:

OLD SUMMIT ROAD PAVEMENT REPAIR PROJECT

The work to be done consists, in general, of repairing damaged areas of Old Summit Road through digouts, placing two inches of asphalt overlay, or seal coating as specified on the location map in these special provisions.

Plans, specifications, and proposal forms for bidding this project can only be obtained at the office of the Director of Public Works, Room 410, 701 Ocean Street, Santa Cruz, California. No deposit is required.

The successful bidder shall furnish a payment bond and a performance bond.

The contractor shall possess a Class A license at the time that this contract is awarded.

The Department of Public Works hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for an award.

Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the general prevailing rate of wages in the District has been determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, and such prevailing rate of wages is listed in the State of California, Business and Transportation Agency, Department of Transportation's publication entitled General Prevailing Wage Rates, current edition, on file in the office of the Director of Public Works.
