SUBJECT: SUBMITTAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION'S CITY/COUNTY

FUNDING REQUEST FORM

Members of the Board:

Pursuant to Section 145 8 1 (a)(4)(A) of the California Beverage Container Recycling and Litter Reduction Act, the Department of Conservation's Division of Recycling (Division) is required to distribute a total of \$10,500,000 to eligible cities and counties for beverage container recycling and litter cleanup activities.

Unincorporated Santa Cruz County has been allocated \$40,250 for fiscal year 1999/2000. This figure was based upon the population of the unincorporated county, as stated in the Annual Demographic Report submitted to the Governor by the Department of Finance. These funds will be made available to cities and counties annually, and they must be used for the specific purpose of promoting the collection and recycling of beverage containers, Public Works advocates the use of these funds for a variety of activities.

As stated in our letter to the Board dated March 30, 2000, Public Works recommends the allocation of \$20,000 to the Central Coast Recycling Media Coalition (CCRMC), which is using funds from jurisdictions in the tri-county area (Santa Cruz, Monterey, and San Benito), to promote beverage container recycling on local television and radio programs. The CCRMC has requested 50 percent of these funds from every city and county entity in the tri-county area to fund the production and airing of these public service announcements. By pooling our resources, we avoid duplicating efforts and can purchase larger media buys for less.

Public Works recommends the purchase of an electronic message board to promote beverage container recycling to those residents who choose not to subscribe to curbside collection. This message board would be located at the entrance to the Buena Vista Landfill gatehouse at an estimated cost of \$10,000 and would be programmed and updated by staff to provide information on local beverage container recycling programs.

We also recommend an allotment of \$10,250 toward local public education efforts. Public Works would like to promote recycling through the purchase and distribution of refrigerator magnets, which would provide specific information regarding beverage container redemption locations in areas of the county that do not heavily subscribe to curbside collection and are most in need of this important information,

A copy of the funding Request Form for this program is attached for your reference. The Division must first approve the specific programs proposed for funding prior to distribution of funds. After Division approval, we will return to your Board to accept the funds as unanticipated revenue along with the necessary documents to implement the approved program expenditures.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

- 1. Adopt the attached resolution authorizing the Department of Public Works to submit the Department of Conservation Division of Recycling's City/County Funding Request Form for promoting the collection and recycling of beverage containers.
- 2. Authorize the Director of Public Works to sign the Department of Conservation Division of Recycling's City/County Funding Request Form on behalf of the County.

WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have, enacted the California Beverage Container Recycling and Litter Reduction Act that provides funds to cities and counties for beverage container recycling and litter cleanup activities; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Conservation's Division of Recycling has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of the program within the State of California, setting up necessary procedures for cities and counties or their designees under the program; and

WHEREAS, per Section 145 8 1 (a)(4)(E) of the California Beverage Container Recycling and Litter Reduction Act, the eligible participant must submit the request form by the due date and time in order to request funds from the Department of Conservation's Division of Recycling.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Santa Cruz County Board of Supervisors authorizes the submittal of the Funding Request Form to the Department of Conservation's Division of Recycling. The Director of Public Works, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute the funding request form in the name of the County of Santa Cruz specified in the Section 1458 1 (a)(4)(A) of the California Beverage Container Recycling and Litter Reduction Act and provide information regarding this program to the Department of Conservation's Division of Recycling upon request.
