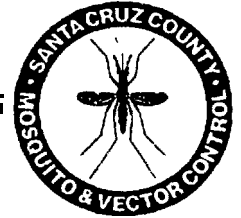

2000-01 Mosquito Abatement/Vector Control County Service Area No. 53 Assessment

Dear Members of the Board:

The attached resolutions establish assessment rates for Mosquito Abatement/Vector Control County Service Area No. 53 for fiscal year 2000-01 and subsequent fiscal years. These assessments will provide funding necessary to operate a mosquito abatement program in Zones of Benefit No. 2 and No. 4 (located within the Aptos and Pajaro districts). There are no changes in the rates established by the Board by Resolution 223-99 on June 8, 1999 for the 1999-00 fiscal year.

Assessment Rate Reports will be placed on file with the Clerk of the Board on or before May 22, 2000, which will allow sufficient time for public review prior to the proposed June 13, 2000 public hearing, at which time your Board will consider establishing and approving the assessment rates and Assessment Rate Report. As provided in Chapter 4.26 of the County Code, the Assessment Rate Reports must be approved by your Board and forwarded to the Auditor-Controller by August 10, 2000.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board:

Adopt the attached resolution setting Tuesday, June 13, 2000, during the morning agenda (which starts at 9:00 a.m.), as the date for a public hearing *on* the proposed Assessment Rates and Assessment Rate Report for Mosquito Abatement/Vector Control County Service Area No. 53 and direct the Clerk of the Board to publish the attached Notice of Public Hearing in the manner prescribed by law.

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

RESOLUTION SETTING HEARING ON PROPOSED ASSESSMENT RATES AND ON

Street, Santa Cruz, California, the Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing on the proposed Assessment Rates and on the proposed Assessment Rate Report for County Service Area No. 53, Mosquito and Vector Control District for the 2000-01 fiscal year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that at the time, date and place above, the Board of Supervisors shall hear all objections or protests, if any, to the proposed rates and report.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall cause notice of the filing of the proposed Assessment Rate Report and the time, date, and place of hearing, to be published at least two weeks prior to the

date set for hearing, in a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in Santa Cruz County, pursuant to Government Code Section 6066 and County Code Section 4.26.150.


