#### RESOLUTION NO.

On the motion of Supervisor duly seconded by Supervisor the following resolution is adopted:

## RESOLUTION APPOINTING SAMUEL TORRES, JR. AS COUNTY COUNSEL FOR THE COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ

WHEREAS, the office of County Counsel has become vacant due to the retirement of Dwight L. Herr, effective April 28, 2000;

WHEREAS, Dwight L. Herr has agreed to continue to provide the services of County Counsel, under contract through June 14, 2000;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has considered a diverse field of candidates to fill the vacancy created and on May 12, 2000 selected Samuel Torres, Jr. as the best qualified individual for the position.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that pursuant to Sections 2 of 7640 et. seq. the Government Code, Samuel Torres, Jr. be and is hereby appointed County Counsel for the County of Santa Cruz for the four year term prescribed by law, said term to commence June 10, 2000. The County Counsel shall be paid at the fifth step of the existing salary range for County Counsel. Said salary shall be paid in installments by the Auditor-Controller in the same manner as other County employees are paid. The County Counsel shall receive all the benefits conferred upon other executive management employees including sick leave, insurances, vacation, holidays, mileage and travel expenses, step advances, salary schedule changes and retirement benefits under the State Public Employees Retirement System which the County participates as a contracting agency and as may be modified by the Board of Supervisors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that Samuel Torres, Jr. shall devote full time to discharging the duties of County Counsel as prescribed in the California Government Code and shall endorse his acceptance of this appointment in the place provided therefore.
