SUBJECT: ADDITIONS TO WORK CONTRACT NO. 92041

Dear Members of the Board:

On March 7, 2000 your Board approved a contract with Rehak Construction for repair of the wall tile in the locker rooms at the Simpkins Family Swim Center. The original contract, in the amount of \$21,000 with a \$2,100 contingency, was to install an additional tile wainscot along the wall in both the men's and women's interior locker rooms to prevent water damage and facilitate cleaning.

Upon removal of the damaged wall board it was discovered that the existing finished plaster walls varied in thickness from 5/8" to 3/4". In order to provide a flush surface for the existing wallboard to match the tile wainscot each stud needed to be 'shimmed out' to attain a uniform thickness. Additionally, several other minor construction changes were needed. The shower corners in each restrooms were found to have regular drywall behind the tile. The drywall in this area had completely disintegrated and needed to be removed and replaced with appropriate materials. The foyer entrance to both locker rooms had rotted drywall so additional ceramic tile was recommended. Additional tile in three locations was needed to match existing tile height and to accommodate wall fixtures such as drinking fountains, fire extinguisher boxes and waste receptacles.

These modifications described above exceeded the amount authorized in the original project contingency fund. Due to the fact that both interior locker rooms at the Simpkins Family Swim Center were closed during the project, staff authorized the additional work to allow the project to be completed as scheduled.

The original estimate for the project was \$30,000 and there are sufficient funds available in the Plant Budget, Index 192 166, Sub Object 6610, to cover the additional construction charges. The total change orders costs for the project amounted to \$7,095, bringing the total contract cost to \$28,095.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board:

- 1. Approve the amended agreement NO. 92041 to increase funds in the amount of \$4,995 from Plant Budget Index 192 166, Sub Object 6610; and
- 2. Authorize the Director of Parks, Open Space and Cultural Services to sign the Amendment to the Agreement, and approve change orders to the Simpkins Tile Repair Project up to \$7,095.
