SUBJECT: Security Services

Dear Members of the Board:

On May 25, 1999, your Board approved a contract with First Alarm Security and Patrol for miscellaneous security services for the Parks Department. These services include park openings and closings, the Summer Parking Program and monitoring sound levels at Pinto Lake County Park and limited miscellaneous security services. At this time the Department is requesting to revise this agreement for the current season beginning Memorial Day weekend with the following changes.

Several new park site closings have been added to the existing agreement with First Alarm Security and Patrol. The agreement before your Board reflects combining all 18 park closings into one daily service cost. This new cost is \$93.75 per day for a annual total of \$34,219.00.

Additionally, the Parks Department has relied upon First Alarm Security and Patrol to provide weekend openings of several parks sites. Due to the increase in the number of sites that need daily opening the Department is requesting to expand the park opening service provided by First Alarm Security and Patrol. The Department is requesting that all 18 park sites be opened by First Alarm Security and Patrol on weekends during the period of Memorial Day through Labor Day. Polo Grounds County Park would continue to be opened by First Alarm Security and Patrol on weekends through the end of the soccer season. The cost for these weekend summer openings is \$87.50 per day for a total of \$2800. The cost for opening the Polo Grounds Park through soccer season is \$6.75 per day for a total of \$375.00.

The continuation of this agreement with First Alarm Security and Patrol and the addition of new park openings and closings will allow the Department to reduce after hours use of parks, protect park property and provide needed weekend access for park users.

It is therefore **RECOMMENDED** that your Board:

- 1. Amend the existing agreement with First Alarm Security and Patrol CO#91618 for the 2000 season beginning Memorial Day weekend, May 26. Funding is already provided for in the current contract.
- 2. Place the contract on the list of continuing agreements for fiscal year 2000/2001 for a total of \$61,973.00.
- 3. Authorize the Director of County Parks to execute the contract on behalf of the County.

## AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

The parties hereto agree to amend that certain Agreement dated May 25, 1999, by and between the COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ, and FIRST ALARM SECURITY AND PATROL, by extending the terms of the Agreement through June 30, 2001; for the following services:

- Opening the gates and restrooms of all parks EXCEPT Polo Grounds Park on weekends 1 from May 27<sup>th</sup> (Memorial Day, Saturday) until September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2000 (Labor Day, Monday). Total days: 32 Days Service Rate \$87.50 per day Total: \$2,800.00
- Opening Polo Grounds Park on the weekends from May 27<sup>th</sup> until November 26<sup>th</sup>, 2000 2. Total days: 60 Days Service Rate: \$6.25 per day Total: \$375.00
- 3. Closing of all 18 parks listed beginning June 1, 2000 Service Rate \$93.75 per day Total: \$34,218.75
- Continuation of the parking program Memorial Day to Labor Day 4. Service Rate \$675 per day Total: \$22,275.00
- 5. Additional Guard Services as needed for special events with a rate of \$18 per hour or \$25 per hour if overtime is required or if services are scheduled less than 2 weeks in advance. Total not-to-exceed: \$2,304.00

Total contract for above services not-to-exceed \$61,972.75.

All other provisions of said agreement shall remain the same.
