2. <u>-Occurrence</u>: Flooding and continued threat of flooding to 2967 Freedom Boulevard and drainage of County culvert with unsafe ecoli levels onto 2967 Freedom Blvd.

DATE: From Jan 7, 2000 to Present

Circumstances of occurrence or transaction giving rise to claim: *

- (1) On or about the weekend of February 12, 2000, Freedom Lake flooded claimant's property at 2867 Freedom Boulevard, including claimants' home and structures.
- (2) In the event of heavy rains, Freedom Lake continues to threaten to flood the property known as 2967 Freedom Boulevard; and
- (2) A County owned culvert has drained and continues to drain onto 2967 Freedom Boulevard, the waters emanating from this culvert contain ecoli levels that are unsafe for human and domestic pet contact.
- 4. General description of indebtedness, obligation, injury, damage or loss incurred so far as is now known:

Thus far, 2967 Freedom Boulevard has sustained the following damage:

- (1) Repeated flooding which damaged the exterior and interior (including structural elements and mechanical members) and fixtures, furnishings and furniture of both the residence and storage shed on said property all as set forth in the attached list marked Exhibit A;
- (2) Continued threat of flooding;
- (3) Pati Parodi and Erica Sumner have both lost time from work in order to repair and otherwise address the damages caused by flood, and to attempt to prevent flood damage;
- (4) Out of pocket expenses to repair and address flood damage; and
- (5) Repeated drainage of unsafe and unhealthy water from a County owned culvert.
