SUBJECT: ROBERTS ROAD STORM DAMAGE REPAIR PROJECT, DSR 5 1465 - DR 1203 COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 37 (DISTRICT 5)

Members of the Board:

The plans, specifications and engineer's estimate for the Roberts Road Storm Damage Repair Project, County Service Area No. 37, are complete and presented here for your consideration and approval. The project provides for repair and rebuilding of a 60-foot portion of the embankment, and reconstruction of a portion of the roadway which was damaged during the El **Niño** storm of March 1998.

The engineer's estimate for this project is \$57,915.00, not including contingencies and administration. Sufficient funds are included in the proposed 2000/01 budget to complete this work.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

- 1. Approve the plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate and authorize calling for bids.
- 2. Set bid opening for 10:45 a.m. on June 27, 2000.

3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise a Notice to Contractors for a ten-day period beginning June 11, 2000, in accordance with provisions of the Public Contract Code Section 20392.

Sealed proposals shall be delivered to the Director of Public Works of Santa Cruz County, Room 410, Governmental Center, no later than 10:30 a.m., June 27, 2000 and at 10:45 a.m. or soon after, they will be publicly opened and read, in the Supervisors' Hearing Room, 701 Ocean Street, Santa Cruz, California, for a storm damage repair project on Roberts Road (County Service Area #37) in accordance with the specifications therefor, to which special reference is made, as follows:

ROBERTS ROAD (CSA #37) STORM DAMAGE REPAIR PROJECT DSR #51465

The work to be done consists, in general, of repairing a storm damaged embankment by constructing a gabion buttress structure, drain installation, backfill, roadway repair, and erosion control.

Plans, specifications, and proposal forms for bidding this project can only be obtained at the office of the Director of Public Works, Room 410,701 Ocean Street, Santa Cruz, California. No deposit is required. The successful bidder shall furnish a payment bond and a performance bond. The contractor shall possess a Class A license at the time this contract is awarded.

The Department of Public Works hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for an award.
