# 2000-2001 BENEFIT ASSESSMENT/SERVICE CHARGES FOR COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 9E, STREETSCAPE MAINTENANCE

Dear Members of the Board:

Each year your Board conducts a public hearing for County Service Area No. 9E, Streetscape Maintenance, that sets the benefit assessments/service charges amounts for the following fiscal year and considers the adoption of the Assessments/Service Charges Report.

#### Benefit Assessments/Service Charges

The CSA 9E charge of \$3.08 per single family residence or single commercial parcel, \$1.85 per unit for multi-unit residential or commercial parcel, or \$1.54 for parcels with minor improvements or vacant land is collected from parcels located in the Live Oak/Soquel Redevelopment Project Area. This charge provides for various services to facilitate the long term maintenance of street trees and associated streetscape improvements on major streets within Live Oak and Soquel.

It is recommended that the current charges remain as noted above, the level approved by your Board in 1999-2000. Your Board previously approved continuing this charge as an assessment under Proposition 218, in accordance with the February 3, 1997 letter of County Counsel to your Board.

### **Procedure for Adoption of Service Charges**

Once today's actions have been approved by your Board, Redevelopment Agency staff will prepare and then place the Benefit Assessments/Service Charges Report for County Service Area No. 9E on file with the Clerk of the Board. This report, containing

assessment/service charge for each unit or parcel to be assessed, will be available on or before July 17, 2000, allowing for public review for two weeks prior to the proposed August 1, 2000 public hearing to consider and adopt the Benefit Assessment/Service Charge Reports. The report must be approved by your Board and forwarded to the Auditor-Controller by August 10, 2000.

#### Recommendation

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board take the following actions:

- 1. Adopt the attached resolution setting a public hearing for August 1, 2000, during the morning agenda, on the proposed benefit assessment/service charges and the proposed 2000-2001 Assessment/Service Charge Reports for County Service Area No. 9E, Streetscape Maintenance; and
- 2. Direct the Clerk of the Board to publish the attached Notice of Public Hearing in the manner prescribed by law.
