Deprivation of my civil rights, under the color of authority, false arrest, false imprisoment, Denial of prospective economic advantage and intentional infliction of emotional distress pursuant Title 42, Sec 1983, 1986 and the 4th and 1st Amendments of the Constitution of the United States and the State of California's Constitution

- 3. Circumstances of occurrence or transaction giving rise to claim; While gathering signatures for a statewide ballot initiative I was falsly arrested and imprisoned on a bogus and sham trespassing citizen's complaint which was ultimately dismissed in the "interest of justice".
- 4. General description of indebtedness, obligation, injury, damage or loss incurred so far as is now known; Damages are both economic and non-economic and I claim them to be in excess of one million dollars I estimate my compensatory damages at \$5000,00 which represents the amount I might of earned if not for the unwanted interference of the Sheriffs' Dept. and \$995,000,00 for anxiety, sleeplessness, humiliation, emotional distress, fearfulness and civil rights deprivation and violations ,if a complaint in District Court is filed it will also seek a undetrrmined damage award for punitived damages.
