30th, 32nd, AND 33RD AVENUE STORM DRAIN, SANITARY SEWER, AND SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT - CONSTRUCTION FINANCING

Dear Members of the Board:

In a separate item on today's agenda, the Public Works Department is asking the Board of Supervisors to accept the low bid from Reber Construction Co., Inc., in the amount of \$1,472,506.42 and to authorize award of the construction contract for the Department of Public Works 30th, 32nd, and 33rd Avenue Storm Drain, Sanitary Sewer, and Sidewalk Improvement Project. In order for the funds necessary to award this contract to be available a parallel action is required from you, as the Board of Directors for the Redevelopment Agency.

The contract for this project will complete the Board approved planline for 30th Avenue between East Cliff Drive and Scriver Street including two IO foot wide travel lanes defined by roadway striping, two 8 foot parking shoulders, curb and gutter on the east side, curb, gutter and 4 foot contiguous sidewalk on the west side, and bulb-outs around existing trees and at the intersections of Scriver Street, Hawes Drive and Calla Drive. In addition to the approved planline improvements, the 30th Avenue construction project also includes the construction of underground drainage facilities on 30th Avenue, Calla Drive, Hawes Drive and 32nd Avenue, as well as replacement of sanitary sewer improvements. Construction is expected to commence in July of this year. As explained in the letter from Public Works, due to the Coastal Commission appeal of the permit for the drainage and sidewalk improvements, staff is requesting that the Board authorize the award of the project pending Coastal Commission approval of the project at it's July meeting.

The sidewalk and storm drain improvements are being financed by the Redevelopment Agency and the sanitary sewer improvements are being financed by the Santa Cruz County Sanitation District. The Redevelopment Agency and Sanitation District will share the cost of the street overlay. The Redevelopment Agency's share of the contract for construction

of these improvements, including overhead and contingency is \$1,017,600. Funds for this project are available within current year capital project appropriations, however, it will be necessary to transfer funds from the Agency's reserves to award this contract. Adequate funds exist within project reserves to cover this transfer. A Resolution authorizing that transfer is included as Attachment 1.

Redevelopment Agency staff has determined that the project is of benefit to the Project Area, that no other reasonable means of financing the improvements are available to the community, that the project will assist in the elimination of blight, and that the project is consistent with the Redevelopment Agency's Five Year Implementation Plan.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board, as the Board of Directors for the Redevelopment Agency, take the following actions:

- 1. Approve Agency funds totaling \$1,017,600 for the cost of the construction contract for the Department of Public Works 30th, 32nd, and 33rd Avenue Storm Drain, Sanitary Sewer, and Sidewalk Improvement Project;
- 2. Approve the attached Resolution Accepting Unanticipated Revenue totaling \$135,000 from the Redevelopment Agency Capital Projects Bond Proceeds Reserves; and
- 3. Concur with and adopt the associated findings.

Dear Members of the Board:

In a separate item on today's agenda, the Public Works Department is asking the Board of Supervisors to accept the low bid from Reber Construction Co., Inc., in the amount of \$1,472,506.42 and to authorize award of the construction contract for the Department of Public Works 30^{th} , 32^{nd} , and 33^{rd} Avenue Storm Drain, Sanitary Sewer, and Sidewalk Improvement Project. In order for the funds necessary to award this contract to be available a parallel action is required from you, as the Board of Directors for the Redevelopment Agency.

The contract for this project will complete the Board approved planline for 30th Avenue between East Cliff Drive and Scriver Street including two 10 foot wide travel lanes defined by roadway striping, two 8 foot parking shoulders, curb and gutter on the east side, curb, gutter and 4 foot contiguous sidewalk on the west side, and bulb-outs around existing trees and at the intersections of Scriver Street, Hawes Drive and Calla Drive. In addition to the approved planline improvements, the 30th Avenue construction project also includes the construction of underground drainage facilities on 30th Avenue, Calla Drive, Hawes Drive and 32nd Avenue, as well as replacement of sanitary sewer improvements. Construction is expected to commence in July of this year. As explained in the letter from Public Works, due to the Coastal Commission appeal of the permit for the drainage and sidewalk improvements, project will need to proceed in a phased approach, with the sanitary sewer work beginning in July and the remaining work proceeding in a fashion consistent with the resolution of the appeal. The letter from Public Works addresses the details of how this phasing could be accomplished. staff is requesting that the Board authorize the award of the project pending Coastal Commission approval of the project at it's July meeting.

The sidewalk and storm drain improvements are being financed by the Redevelopment

Agency and the sanitary sewer improvements are being financed by the Santa Cruz County Sanitation District. The Redevelopment Agency and Sanitation District will share the cost of the street overlay. The Redevelopment Agency's share of the contract for construction of these improvements, including overhead and contingency is \$1,017,600. Funds for this project are available within current year capital project appropriations, however, it will be necessary to transfer funds from the Agency's reserves to award this contract. Adequate funds exist within project reserves to cover this transfer. A Resolution authorizing that transfer is included as Attachment 1.

Redevelopment Agency staff has determined that the project is of benefit to the Project Area, that no other reasonable means of financing the improvements are available to the community, that the project will assist in the elimination of blight, and that the project is consistent with the Redevelopment Agency's Five Year Implementation Plan.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board, as the Board of Directors for the Redevelopment Agency, take the following actions:

- 2. Approve the attached Resolution Accepting Unanticipated Revenue totaling \$135,000 from the Redevelopment Agency Capital Projects Bond Proceeds Reserves; and
- 3. Concur with and adopt the associated findings.
