SUBJECT: AMESTI ROAD AREA LANDSLIDE DEWATERING PROJECT

STATUS REPORT

Members of the Board:

On April 25, 2000, your Board accepted the Final Engineering Report on the subject landslide, which identified the extent of the problem, and directed Public Works, Planning, and Environmental Health to take certain interim actions. Pursuant to the Board's direction, Public Works has included \$120,000 in the 2000/2001 Road Program for repairs to the existing storm drain system along Amesti Road.

Using the data developed by IT/EMCON, Planning has prepared an appeal of the original damage survey report which **dealt** with the Amesti Road Area Landslide that was suspended in 1995 by the Federal Emergency Managment Agency until the slide could be stabilized. Planning will not know the results of that appeal until later this year, and at that time they will report back to your Board on what funding could be made available for landslide stabilization measures. Environmental Health will also report back at that time on the status of their public education program concerning water use in the Crow Avenue community.

It is therefore recommended that your Board accept this status report on the Amesti Road Area Landslide Dewatering Project and direct Planning, Environmental Health, and Public Works to report back to the Board on October 3, 2000, on 'their progress.
