SUBJECT: FIFTH AVENUE / LAKE AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS, EAST CLIFF DRIVE TO EATON STREET


Members of the Board:

Pursuant to Board direction, Public Works staff has applied for and received a Transportation Enhancement Act (TEA) grant for the construction of sidewalks on Fifth Avenue and Lake Avenue between East Cliff Drive and Eaton Street, along the east side of the Small Craft Harbor. The approved grant funding, in the amount of \$300,000, is earmarked for construction, and will be available in the 2001-02 fiscal year.

In order to allow work to begin on a plan line, community meetings, field surveys, and preliminary design, it is necessary that the Board adopt the accompanying Resolution Accepting Unanticipated Revenue to appropriate funds in the amount of \$50,000 in the current year budget. Funds are available in the Live Oak Roadside Improvement Fund for this work.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors adopt the attached Resolution Accepting Unanticipated Revenue in the amount of \$50,000 for the Fifth Avenue / Lake Avenue Improvement Project.


