SUBJECT: COUNTY WIDE STORM DAMAGE REPAIR PROJECTS FOR:
HAZEL DEL ROAD, POST MILES 2.08 TO 2.77
GRANITE CREEK ROAD, POST MILES 0.45 AND 1.50
NORTH RODEO GULCH ROAD POST MILES 0.17 TO 4.80
SWANTON ROAD, POST MILES 4.75 TO 5.20
(96-07, 1155 AND 1203 DISASTERS)

Members of the Board:

The individual plans, specifications, and engineer's estimates for the four subject storm damage repair projects have been completed by our design consultants and are presented here for your consideration and approval. Work on these four roads provides for the repair of storm damages which resulted from the last three storm disaster years (1996, 1997 and 1998). These projects, which include a total seventeen Damage Survey Report (**DSR**) sites, will allow for the repair of eroded roadway shoulders using a combination of rock slope protection (revetment) and the installation of several concrete cribwalls.

These projects, as presented, are based on the scope of work of repairs included in the approved DSR, so as to return the damage sites to their original predisaster condition. The plans and specifications thus provide for repairs which essentially match the existing roadways in the vicinity of the repair sites, pursuant to the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (**FEMA**) approved scopes of work. In those instances where the funding approved for a DSR repair falls short of the actual bid price, we will submit a supplemental funding request to FEMA for the full cost of repair.

The engineer's estimates for these four projects are as follows: Granite Creek Road, \$140,000; Hazel Dell Road, \$240,000; North Rodeo Gulch Road, \$270,000; and **Swanton Road**, \$260,000, not including contingencies or administration. Since all of these estimates exceed the actual DSR amounts, supplemental funding will be necessary. In addition to the funding already included in the approved 2000/2001 Road Program, other monies are available that can be used to offset these costs until our supplemental **funding** requests are approved by FEMA

In order to start construction of these critical projects as soon as possible and to provide for the largest potential number of bidders, it will be necessary to open bids prior to the first available Board meeting in September. Public Works is therefore requesting that the Board allow the opening of sealed bids for the subject projects in the office of the Director of Public Works on August 29, 2000 (North Rodeo Gulch Road and Hazel Del Road) and on September 5, 2000 (Granite Creek Road and Swanton Road). The four resultant low bids would then be returned for the Board's acceptance on September 12, 2000. It would be Public Works' intention to request authorization to award all four projects to the low bidders on that same Board date.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Approve the plans, specifications, and engineer's estimates and authorize calling for bids for each of these four storm damage repair projects.
2. Set the bid openings for 10:45 A.M. on August 29, 2000, for North Rodeo Gulch Road and Hazel Del Road, and on September 5, 2000, for Granite Creek Road and Swanton Road.
3. Adopt the attached resolution allowing the bid opening for the four subject projects to take place in the office of the Director of Public Works at 10:45 A.M. on August 29, 2000, and on September 5, 2000, with acceptance and award by the Board on September 12, 2000.
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise a Notice to Contractors for a ten-day period beginning August 12, 2000, for all four projects in accordance with the provisions of Public Contract Code Section 203 92.






