TO REQUEST A TEMPORARY TRANSFER OF FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Aptos/La Selva Fire Protection District may be in need of financial assistance during the period of July 1, 2000 to April 30, 2001; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz, by Resolution 616-67, declared its approval of and intention to provide needed tax anticipation funds pursuant to Constitution Article XVI, Section 6;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of Directors of the Aptos/La Selva Fire Protection District hereby determines and declares that:

- 1. The sum of two million five hundred thousand (\$2,500,000) dollars may be needed in anticipation of Service Charge Revenues for the operation and maintenance of said district through April 30, 2001.
- 2. Said sum of \$2,500,000 requested does not exceed 85% of the anticipated Service Charge Revenues for the tax year.
- 3. The District agrees to repay this loan by April 30, 2001 together with interest at the current rate per annum received on similar types of investments by the county as determined by the County Treasurer.
- 4. The Secretary to this Board shall forward three certified copies of this resolution to the Auditor-Controller of the County of Santa Cruz so that the request may be signed and presented to the Board of Supervisors for approval.


