Mardi Wormhoudt and Staff:

T am very interested in serving on the Women's Commission. I feel that I could both contribute to and learn from the commission. I am currently working full time (through December) as an intern at Legal Aid doing CalWORKs advocacy. I have both a personal and theoretical understanding of the CAlWORKs program and the issues that low-income women and mothers face. 1 am a single mother, a survivor of domestic violence, and have been receiving welfare for the past six years. I have firsthand experience of the transformation of the welfare system following the "reform" of '96. I have gained a theoretical perspective as a result of numerous classes I have taken focusing on gender, race and class issues.

I am on the board of a local nonprofit that presents prejudice reduction and conflict resolution workshops to community businesses and organizations. I have been on this board for over a year, and I am currently serving as treasurer/bookkeeper for the organization. In addition, while I was a student at Cabrillo I served on the Student Senate for one year, where I was very active in working with other students to address several serious issues that arose. I also served on several committees (Bilingual Education Committee, Parent Advisory Committee) at the Cabrillo College Children's Center during the years that my son attended the program.

I fcel that serving on the Women's Commission (and the subcommittee on welfare reform) would both enrich my knowledge of the needs of women in our community and complement the advocacy work that I am doing at Legal Aid.
