> AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA 14TH DISTRICT AGRICULTURAL ASSOCIATION (DAA) AND THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR ADDITIONAL SECURITY SERVICES AT THE SANTA CRUZ COUNTY FAIR. **SEPTEMBER 12-17, 2000**

The Sheriffs Office is responsible for enforcing state laws and county ordinances at the Santa Cruz County Fair, held annually at the Santa Cruz County Fairgrounds in Watsonville. Sheriffs Deputies respond routinely to criminal incidents, security needs, traffic control and numerous other needs of the many visitors to the Fair.

As in previous years, the Fair management has asked the Sheriffs Office to provide additional services to enhance security at the fairgrounds during this year's six-day event, September 12 through 17, 2000. The attached agreement calls for the 14" DAA to pay the Sheriffs Office \$10,000 (\$7,000 for additional Patrol services and \$3,000 for the services of the Sheriffs Reserves and the Mounted and Motorcycle Posse Units); the Sheriffs Office FY 00-01 budget includes \$7,000 for services to the Fair.

It is, therefore, recommended that your Board:

1. Approve the attached agreement between the State of California 14<sup>th</sup> District Agricultural Association and the Sheriffs Office in the amount of \$10,000 for security services at the 2000 Santa Cruz County Fair, and authorize the Sheriff-Coroner to sign and execute the agreement, and

2. Adopt the attached resolution accepting and appropriating \$3,000 in unanticipated revenue for law enforcement services provided by the Sheriffs Office to the 2000 Santa Cruz County Fair.

WITNESSETH: That the Contractor for and in consideration of the covenants, conditions, agreements, and stipulations of the State hereinafter expressed, does hereby agree to furnish to the State services and materials as follows: (Set forth service to be rendered by Contractor, amount to be caid Contractor, time for performance or completion, and altach plans and specifications, if any.)

Contractor agrees to act as Security Liaison-for the 14<sup>th</sup> District Agricultural Association and Fairgrounds Security for the 2000 Santa Cruz County Fair located on the fairgrounds at 2601 East Lake Avenue, Watsonville, CA 95076, September 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 2000.

Contractor agrees to assist Fairgrounds Security with security problems that may arise during the Annual Fair. Contractor notes that the Fair's carnival will remain open one (1) hour following close of Fair each night.

Contractor agrees to provide assistance not to exceed Seven Thousand (\$7,000) plus additional Reserve Deputies, Mounted Posse, and Motorcycle support not to exceed Three Thousand (\$3,000) and any other volunteer groups to be determined by the Sheriffs Department.

Sheriffs Reserves agree to transport any person(s) incarcerated during fairtime.

The attached Standard Contract Terms and Conditions and Drug Free Workplace become a part of this Agreement.

Contractor's obligation to indemnify, defend and save harmless shall not apply to any claims or losses accruing or resulting to any person, firm, or corporation, including Contractor's Deputy Sheriffs, Reserve Deputy Sheriffs, Mounted Posse, and Motorcycle Posse who may be injured or damaged by the intentional acts or sole negligence of the State,

## STANDARD AGREEMENT

- 1. The Contractor agrees to indemnify, defend and save harmless the State, its officers, agents and employees from any and all claims and losses accruing or resulting to any and all contractors, subcontractors, materialmen, laborers and any other person, firm or corporation furnishing or supplying work services, materials or supplies in connection with the performance of this contract, and from any and all claims and losses accruing or resulting to any person, firm or corporation who may be injured or damaged by the Contractor in the performance of this contract.
- 2. The Contractor, and the agents and pmployees of Contractor, in the performance of the agreement, shall act in an independent capacity and not as **officers** or employees or agents of State of California.
- 3. The State may terminate this agreement and be relieved of the payment of any consideration to Contractor should Contractor fail to perform the covenants herein contained at the time and in the manner herein provided. In the event of such termination the State may proceed with the work in any manner deemed proper by the State. The cost to the State shall be deducted from any sum due the Contractor under this agreement, and the balance, if any, shall be **paid** the Contractor upon demand.
- 4, Without the written consent of the State, this agreement is not assignable by Contractor either in whole or in part.
- 5. Time is of the essence in this agreement.
- 6. No alteration or variation of the terms of this contract shall be valid unless made in writing and signed by the parties hereto, and no oral understanding or agreement not incorporated herein, shall be binding on any of the parties hereto.
- 7. The consideration to be paid Contractor, as provided herein, shall be in compensation for all of Contractor's expenses incurred in the performance hereof, including travel and per diem, unless otherwise expressly so provided.

## STANDARD **CONTRACT TERMS** AND CONDITIONS (STD. FORM 2, STANDARD AGREEMENT)

- Contractor shall maintain all financial records relating to this contract for a period of three years after final payment of this contract or until audited by the State, whichever occurs first, and shall be available for inspection or audit at any reasonable time (Gov Code Section 10532).
- Contractor, by signing this contract, does swear under penalty of perjury that no more than one final
  unappealable finding of contempt of court by a Federal Court has been issued against contractor
  within the immediately preceding two-year period because of the contractor's failure to comply with
  an order of a Federal Court which orders the contractor to comply with an order of National Labor
  Relations Board (Public Contract Code Section 10296).
- 3. Contractor shall provide a worker's compensation insurance certificate if worker's compensation is required for this contract. This determination will be made by the fair.
- 4. If, during the performance of this agreement, a dispute arises between contractor and Fair Management which cannot be settled by discussion, the contractor shall submit a written statement within eight hours of the incident giving rise to the dispute to Fair Management. A decision by Fair Management shall be made to the Contractor within four hours, in waiting, and shall be final and conclusive. Contractor shall continue to perform contract requirements without interruption during the dispute period.
- 5. It is understood and agreed that this contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of California both as to interpretation and performance.
- discriminate harass or allow harassment against any employee or applicant for employment because of sex, race, color, ancestry, religious creed, national origin, physical disability (including HIV and AIDS), mental disability, medical condition(cancer), age (over 40), marital status, and denial of family care leave. Contractors and subcontractors shall ensure that the evaluation and treatment of their employees and applicants for employment are free of such discrimination and harassment. Contractors and subcontractors shall comply with the provision of the Fair Employment and Housing Act (Gov. Code Section 12900, et seq.) and the applicable regulations promulgated thereunder (CA Code of Regulations, Title 2, Section 7285.0, et seq.). The applicable regulations of the Fair Employment and Housing Commission implementing Gov. Code Section 12990 (a-f), set forth in Ch. 5 of Div.: 4 of Title 2 of the CA Code of Regulations are incorporated into this contract by reference and made part hereof as if set form in full. Contractor and its subcontractors shall give written notice of their obligations under this clause to labor organizations with which they have a collective bargaining or other agreement. This contractor shall include the nondiscrimination and compliance provisions of this clause in all subcontracts to perform work under this contract.
- Contractor by signing this contract hereby certifies, unless specifically exempted, compliance with Gov. Code Sect. 12990 (a-f) and CA Code of Regulations, Title 2, Div.. 4, Ch. 5 in matters relating to reporting requirements and the development, implementation and maintenance of a Nondiscrimination Program. Prospective contractor agrees not to unlawfully discriminate, harass or allow harassment against any employee or applicant for employment because of sex, race, color, ancestry, religious creed, national origin physical disability (including HIV and AIDS), mental disability, medical condition (cancer), age (over 40), marital status, and denial of family care leave.

If M/W/DVBE compliance is required, contractor or vendor agrees that the awarding department or its delegatee will have the right to review, obtain, and copy all records pertaining to performance of the contract. Contractor or vendor agrees to provide the awarding department or its delegatee with any relevant information requested and shall permit the awarding department or its delegatee access to its premises, upon reasonable notice, during normal business hours for the purpose of interviewing employees and inspecting and copying such books, records, accounts, and other material that may be relevant to a matter under investigation for the purpose of determining compliance with PCC Sect. 10 115 et seq., and Title 2, CA Code of Regulations, Sect. 1896.60 et seq. The fair reserves the right to terminate any agreement, at any time, upon order of the Board of Directors by giving the contractor awarded the contract notice, in writing, at least 30 days prior to the date when such termination shall become effective. Such termination shall relieve the fair of any further payments, obligations, and/or performances required in the terms of the agreement.
- 10. By signing this contract, Contractor assures the state that it complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990, (42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.), which prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability, as well as all applicable regulations arid guidelines issued pursuant to the ADA.
- 11. By signing this contract, the contractor or grantee hereby certifies under penalty of perjury under the law of the State of California that the contractor or grantee will comply with the requirements of the Drug-Free Workplace Act of 1990 (Government Code Section 8350 et set.), and will provide a drug-free workplace by taking the following actions:
  - (1) Publish a statement notifying employees that unlawful manufacture, distribution dispensation, possession, or use of a controlled substance is prohibited and specifying actions to be taken against employees for violations.
  - (2) Establish a Drug-Free Awareness Program to inform employees about:
    - (a) The dangers of drug abuse in the workplace,
