SUBJECT: FEDERAL FUNDING PROGRAM SUPPLEMENT - SOQUEL DRIVE

IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AT CABRILLO COLLEGE

Members of the Board:

Attached for your Board's approval are an original and duplicate original of Program Supplement Number MO23 for incorporation into County-State Agreement Number 05-5936 with an authorizing Resolution. This agreement provides \$750,000 in federal **funding** reimbursement for the Soquel Drive Improvement Project now under construction at Cabrillo College. Cabrillo College will fund the remaining balance of the Soquel Drive Improvement Project and the Cabrillo College Drive Realignment Project at an estimated cost of **\$3,000,000** through the expenditure of their bond measure.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action.

- 1. Approve Program Supplement Number MO23 for incorporation into **County-**State Agreement **05-5936**.
- 2. Adopt the attached resolution authorizing agreement between the State of California and the County of Santa Cruz for funding the construction of the Soquel Drive Improvement Project at Cabrillo College.
- 3. Authorize the Director of Public Works to sign the original and duplicate original of Program Supplement Number MO23 on behalf of the County.

- 4. Direct the Clerk of the Board to return the original and the duplicate original of the signed agreement to **Fardad Falakfarsa**, Office Chief, Design and Local Programs, Southern Project Implementation, California Department of Transportation, P.O. Box 942874, MS #1, Sacramento, CA 94274-0001.
- Authorize payment to Cabrillo College in the amount of \$750,000 for the Soquel Drive Roadway Improvement Project in accordance with the Joint Powers Facilities Construction Agreement approved by your Board on May 9, 2000, upon receipt of the federal funds.

## SPECIAL COVENANTS OR REMARKS

- 1. The Local Agency agrees the payment of Federal funds will be limited to the amounts approved by the Federal Highway Administration in the Federal-Aid Project Agreement (PR-2)/Detail Estimate, or its modification (PR-2A) or the FNM-76, and accepts any increases in Local Agency Funds as shown on the Finance or Bid Letter or its modification as prepared by the Office of Local Programs Project Implementation.
- 2. The Local Agency will advertise, award and administer this project in accordance with the current Local Assistance Procedures Manual.
- 3. This Agreement supplements the Local Agency-State Master Agreement with the understanding that all provisions of the Transportation Equity Act (TEA-21) and CMAQ provisions apply.
- 4. All maintenance, involving the physical condition and the operation of the improvements, referred to in Article III MAINTENANCE of the aforementioned Master Agreement will be the responsibility of the Local Agency and shall be performed at regular intervals or as required for efficient operation of the completed improvements.
