Said application is being presented within a reasonable time after occurrence of said cause of action, not to exceed one year from the date of the occurrence giving rise to the claim

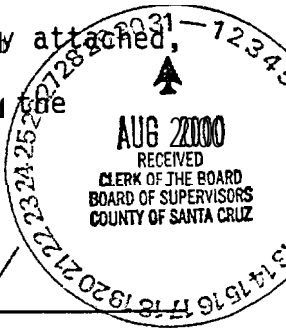
