Dear Members of the Board:

On October 14, 2000, the Rudolph F. Monte Foundation will be presenting their sixth annual fireworks extravaganza. Last year's event included 53 youth and school organizations participating to raise money for their schools. Through the participation of these groups, and with the great turnout for the event, the Monte Foundation was able to distribute over \$400,000.


This year, in response to concerns raised by community members about past events, I will be hosting a community meeting on September 20, 2000, at 7:00 p.m. at the Aptos Library in order to hear concerns and answer questions about the event from interested community members.

While the Board has already approved the necessary road closure to facilitate access for spectators and residents of the area, the Rudolph F. Monte Foundation is requesting the use of two County generators, eight distributor boxes, and two light towers for the event again this year. The Foundation has signed the agreement as written by the Public Works Department indicating their concurrence with the terms and conditions established by the County.

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Accordingly, I recommend that the Board direct the Department of Public Works to provide two generators, eight distributor boxes, and two light towers for use at the Monte Foundation's Sixth Annual Fireworks event, as agreed to by the Rudolph F. Monte Foundation in accordance with the attached agreement.


