RE: BONNY DOON ECOLOGICAL RESERVE PARKING PROBLEMS

Dear Members of the Board:

Attached is a petition from a number of Bonny Doon residents requesting this Board to help respond to serious problems at the Bonny Doon Ecological Reserve. This special environmental area is owned by the State and managed by the State Department of Fish and Game. At this time, a management plan for the property has not been adopted so the Reserve receives minimal oversight. However, there is a good deal of public use and, unfortunately, abuse.

I recently met with neighbors of the Reserve, as well as representatives from the Department of Fish and Game and the Sheriff's Office. Among the problems cited were damage to endangered habitats, nighttime anti-social behavior, trash accumulation, and increased fire dangers. The problems stem from uncontrolled nighttime use and overuse during the daytime. A number of actions to respond to the problems were discussed and these are referred to in the attached petition and, also, in the attached letter from the Department of Fish and Game Regional Manager requesting County assistance.

In light of these serious problems at the Bonny Doon Ecological Reserve, I recommend that the Board of Supervisors take the following actions:

1. Direct the Public Works Department to meet with Bonny Doon Ecological Reserve neighbors and a representative

of the Department of Fish and Game to identify locations for the placement of the minimal number legally possible of no parking signs in the vicinity of the Reserve.

- 2. Approve in concept the attached ordinance adopting no parking restrictions in the area adjacent to the Bonny Doon Ecological Reserve as a separate ordinance and further adopt the attached resolution establishing a penalty of \$100 for violations of the parking restrictions in the Bonny Doon Ecological Reserve Area.
- 3. Direct the Public Works Department to place No Parking Anytime signs, including the amount of the penalty for violations, along Martin Road adjacent to the Bonny Doon Ecological Reserve from Ice Cream Grade to the boundary of the Reserve at the locations identified by the Department in cooperation with the neighbors.
- 4. Request the Sheriff's Office to enforce the no nighttime parking restrictions at the Bonny Doon Ecological Reserve Parking lot.

ORDINANCE ADOPTING SPECIFIC PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR AREAS ADJACENT TO THE BONNY DOON ECOLOGICAL RESERVE

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz ordains as follows:

SECTION I

Section 9.36.050 "Restricted Parking Areas" is hereby amended by adding subsection D to read:

D. Bonny Doon Ecological Reserve Area

No parking shall be allowed at any time within that area adjacent to the Bonny Doon Ecological Reserve Area for which signs indicate this specific parking restriction applies.

SECTION II

This ordinance is declaratory of existing parking restrictions and is adopted as a separate ordinance provision so that a specific penalty can be established for violations of the parking restrictions in the Bonny Doon Ecological Reserve Area.

SECTION III

This ordinance shall take effect on the $31^{\rm st}$ day after the date of final passage.

On the motion of Supervisor duly seconded by Supervisor the following resolution is adopted

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 606-93 ESTABLISHING PARKING PENALTIES

WHEREAS, Section 40203.5 of the California Vehicle Code authorizes the Board of Supervisors to establish a schedule of parking penalties for parking violations, including late payment penalties, administrative fees, and other related charges for parking violations, issued within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that the existing penalty for violations of the restricted parking regulations by which parking is prohibited in the North Coast beach parking areas between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. is insufficient to deter violations in the North Coast beach areas; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has adopted an ordinance establishing parking between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. in the North Coast beach parking areas as a separate violation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the parking penalties established by Resolution No. 606-93 are hereby amended for purposes of Section 40203.5 of the California Vehicle Code by adding the following parking penalty:

Dear Supervisor Wormhoudt:

I have recently had a conversation with our field enforcement personnel concerning the issues at our Bonny Doon Ecological Reserve. I have an understanding of the problems that need to be addressed at the Reserve, and also understand that Department of Fish and Game enforcement personnel have attended several meetings with Reserve neighbors, including a meeting held with you.

As part of a possible solution to the vandalism, trespassing, and other violations occurring in the Bonny Doon area, support the placement of "No Parking Anytime" signs along the roadway to the Ecological Reserve. This is a measure that is also supported by Bonny Doon neighbors and the Santa Cruz County Sheriff's Office.

I will also direct our staff to post the Department-provided unimproved parking lot (near the Bonny Doon Volunteer Fire Department) with signs that state, "No Parking Between 8 PM and 7 AM." Further, I encourage the Sheriff's Office, California Highway Patrol, California State Park Rangers, or any other authorized law enforcement agency to issue citations for parking illegally in the Ecological Reserve. The code section for this violation is 630(a)(4) of the California Code of Regulations, Title i4.

Thank you for your help in addressing the issues that exist at the Reserve.
