Statement of Qualifications and Interest in the Resource Conservation District - John Ricker

The Santa Cruz County Resource Conservation District is playing an increasingly important role in watershed management and water quality protection in Santa Cruz County. As a non-regulatory entity, the District has the confidence of many members of the public and is in a good position to provide public education and technical assistance for erosion control, road restoration and manure management, among other areas.
