SUBJECT: PARKS COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION ON ARTIFICIAL. TURF USAGE IN THE SANTA CRUZ COUNTY PARR SYSTEM

Dear Members of the Board:

On March 7, 2000 your Board directed the Parks Commission to develop a specific policy recommendation on the use of artificial turf in the Santa Cruz County Parks system.

At the Commission's August 2000 meeting, Andrew Rowley, Field Turf, made a presentation on their product to the Commission. The Commissioners were able to see an actual example of the artificial surface material and had the opportunity to ask questions of the Field Turf representative. Several of the Commissioners were concerned about safety and maintenance. The answers to their questions reassured the Commissioners that the artificial turf products currently on the market are extremely safe and relatively maintenance free. Mr. Rowley also informed the Commission that the San Francisco Forty Niners played on the surface the previous weekend and are considering installing the surface. Cabrillo College may use Field Turf on their athletic fields and the owners of Soccer Central, in Watsonville, are going to install a similar product at that facility when it moves to Ramsey Park.

The Commissioners did discuss the need to take several factors into account when the County considers using an artificial surface at a future park site. They felt that the benefits of year round use by the community needed to be considered in light of the potential impacts to the adjacent neighborhoods. Additionally, the water conservation aspect, reduction in pesticide use and the reduced maintenance demands should play a significant role in the decision making process.
