SUBJECT: NORTH COAST BEACHES PROJECT PHASE I, SCOTT CREEK BEACH

Dear Members of the Board:

On October 24, 2000, your Board awarded a contract in the amount of \$506,293 to Reber Construction Company for the North Coast Beaches Project Phase I, Scott Creek Beach. At that time, your Board was informed that due to the complex nature of the project, there would be a need for supplemental contracts for a resident engineer, on-site archaeologist and an environmental control consultant. It was anticipated that the supplemental contracts could be brought back before your Board for approval by November 14, 2000.

The consultant selection process is taking more time than originally anticipated for the resident engineer, due to the expertise and program knowledge required to administer a federally funded project within the requirements of the Caltrans Local Assistance Procedures Manual. The contracts for the on-site archaeologist and environmental consultant will involve negotiating a scope of services with two consultants who have performed previous work on the project and are in tune to the nature of work to come. Given the required time line, the next available date to bring the supplemental contracts before your Board for approval will be December 5, 2000.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board take the following actions:

1. Accept this report from the Department of Parks, Open Space and Cultural Services on the negotiation process for the supplemental contracts for the North Coast Beaches Project Phase I, Scott Creek Beach.
