Re: MICROFILM VIEWERS

Dear Members of the Board,

On July 21, 1981, your Board passed Resolution No. 586-S 1 which in accordance with Government Code §2736 1.4 provides for a Recorder's Micrographic fee. Funds from the fee may be used for improvement of and conversion to micrographics in the Recorder's Office. In 1989 this office used such funds to purchase some microfilm readers so that the public can view recorded documents on microfilm. Those viewers are now in need of frequent repair, with replacement parts becoming more expensive and scarce. It is time to buy new microfilm viewers.

All documents in the Recorder's Office, dating back to the 1850's have been microfilmed. This serves two purposes:

- The original rolls of microfilm are stored in an underground vault in Tahoe City so that if any disaster occurs in Santa Cruz these very important documents can be restored. Microfilm is still the only proven medium for archival storage.
- It provides a relatively easy medium for the public to view these documents and from which the office can make copies as requested. The original recorded documents are returned to the recording party after all indexing, imaging and microfilming are completed.

In 1996 your Board approved a new indexing, imaging and cashiering system in the Recorders Office. As a result all documents recorded since March 1997 have been imaged, allowing staff and customers to view those documents on personal computers in the office. In the near future the index and the imaged documents will be accessible on any PC on the county network. Because microfilm is still the only approved medium for archival storage, the office also purchased equipment that converts the images to microfilm (with the original of that microfilm also being stored in the underground vault).

Although it is the goal of the office to eventually convert all the microfilm in the office (dating back to the 1850's) to electronic images, it is a very time consuming and expensive project. There are over 6,000,000 microfilmed pages. In the meantime, the public is still in need of viewing the microfilm for those documents recorded prior to 1997. The microfilm viewers that have been proven in other Recorder's Offices in the state are the Canon MS 400 Cartridge Roll Film Viewers, at a cost of \$9,500 each, including shipping and taxes. Two such viewers should be adequate at this time. There are sufficient funds in the Recorder's Micrographic Trust to pay for these viewers.

It is therefore recommended that your Board approve the attached resolution accepting unanticipated revenue for the 2000-2001 fiscal year and making available the necessary appropriations to acquire the specified equipment.
