PLANNING COMMISSION RESOLUTION SENDING RECOMMENDATION TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ON PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has held a public hearing on Application No. 98-0869, involving twenty-two properties located adjacent to both sides of Highway 1, beginning at Laguna Creek and extending north to Molino Creek to a pumping station, excluding the RMC Cement Plant and the community of Davenport, and the Planning Commission has considered the proposed rezoning, all testimony and evidence received at the public hearing, and the attached staff report.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Planning Commission recommends that the Board of Supervisors adopt the attached ordinance amending the Zoning Ordinance by conditionally changing APNs 058-021-01, 03 and 07, 058-022-11, 058-042-01, 058-121-01, 02, 058-122-09, 12, 059-011-03, 04, 05, 06, 10, 11 and 13, 059-021-02, 03 and 04 from the "CA" (Commercial Agriculture) to the "CA-P" (Commercial Agriculture-Agricultural Preserve) zone district, and conditionally changing Assessor's Parcel Numbers 058-05 1-05 and 07 from the "RA" (Residential Agriculture) zone district to the "CA-P" (Commercial Agriculture-Agricultural Preserve) zone district and to rezone Assessor's Parcel Number 059-151-01 from the "SU" (Special Use) zone district to the "A-P" (Agriculture-Agricultural Preserve) zone district.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Planning Commission makes findings on the proposed conditional rezoning as contained in the Report to the Planning Commission.
