STATE OF CALIFORNIA ASSEMBLY RULES COMMITTEE LEASE AMENDMENT

Members of the Board:

Your Board's approval is requested for the extension of the existing office space lease agreement between the County of Santa Cruz and the California Assembly Rules Committee to December 31, 2002. The lease provides for Government Center office space for our local Assemblyman. After consultation with the Real Property Division, this agreement was increased to reflect the current fair market rate for comparable office space from \$917.52 per month to \$997 per month.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED your Board:

- 1. Approve the lease amendment with the California Assembly Rules Committee for legislative office space in the County Government Center; and
- 2. Authorize the General Services Director to execute the amendment on behalf of your Board.

SECOND ADDENDUM TO LEASE

This Second Addendum to Lease is made and entered into as of the 15th day of November, 2000, by and between COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ (the "Lessor") and the ASSEMBLY RULES COMMITTEE OF THE CALIFORNIA LEGISLATURE (the "Lessee").

RECITALS

A. The Lessor and Lessee entered into a lease, dated December 1, 1996 (the "Original Lease"), whereby the Lessor leased to Lessee certain office space located at Santa Cruz County Government Center, 701 Ocean Street, Suite 318B, Santa Cruz, CA, 95060 (the "Premises"). The Original Lease was amended by that certain First Addendum to Lease, dated December 18, 1998, by and between the Lessor and Lessee. The Original Lease, as amended by the First Addendum, may be referred to herein as the "Lease".

B. By this First Addendum to Lease, Lessor and Lessee desire to extend the term of the Lease and to otherwise modify the Lease as provided herein.

In consideration of the foregoing recitals and the mutual covenants contained herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereby agree as follows:

AGREEMENT

- 1. Extended Lease Term. The Lease termination date shall be extended such that the Lease shall terminate on December 31, 2002.
- 2. Rent. The Rent shall be amended to the amount of \$997.00 (Nine hundred ninety seven dollars and 00/100) payable on the tenth (1 0th) day of each month commencing January 1, 2001.
- 3. Option to Extend. Lessor grants Rules Committee one (1) option to extend the term for the Premises for a period of two (2) years, subject to agreement between the parties as to fair market rent.

The State of California has elected to be insured for its motor vehicle and general liability exposures through a self-insurance program. The State Attorney General administers the general liability program through an annual appropriation from the General Fund. The Office of Risk and Insurance Management administers the motor vehicle liability program,

Under this form of insurance, the State and its employees (as defined in Section 810.2 of the Government Code) are insured for any tort liability that may develop through carrying out official activities, including state official operations on non-state owned property. Should any claims arise by reason of such operations or under an official contract or license agreement, they should be referred to the Attorney General, State of California, Tort Liability Section, 1300 I Street, P.O. Box 944255, Sacramento, CA 94244-2550.

The State of California has entered into a Master Agreement with the State Compensation Insurance Fund to administer workers' compensation benefits for all state employees, as required by the Labor Code,
