ADOPT RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING UNANTICIPATED REVENUE FROM THE CALIFORNIA LAW ENFORCEMENT TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT PURCHASE (CLETEP II) PROGRAM

Dear Members of the Board:

In its Fiscal Year 2000-01 budget, the California Legislature appropriated \$75 million to be distributed to local law enforcement agencies for technology expenditures. This appropriation constitutes the second phase of the California Law Enforcement Technology Equipment Purchase Program (CLETEP), the first phase of which resulted in a technology award to the Sheriffs Office of \$200,000 in early 2000. This second phase (CLETEP II) required no new application, no local cash or in-kind match, and has already been distributed to local law enforcement agencies on a *per capita* basis. The Santa Cruz County Sheriffs Office has received \$188,122 in CLETEP II funding.

As your Board is aware, the Sheriffs **Office**, working closely with the County Administrative **Office** and the County Information Systems Department, is undertaking a comprehensive reevaluation, reconfiguration and improvement of its technology and information management systems. The four major areas being addressed are: the Records Management System (RMS), the Detention Management System (DMS), the message switcher (communication link between the Sheriffs **Office** and the Department of Justice), and installation of Mobile Data Computers (**MDCs**) in all patrol vehicles.

This multi-year effort began with and continues to include the consulting services of Public Safety Consultants, Inc. The project is proceeding with the acquisition of software and interface tools and the necessary hardware and related equipment. Your Board has approved the funding of this complex project through a combination of County Technology Fund monies and Sheriff's Office revenues, such as SB-90 funds (state mandated reimbursement), drug asset forfeiture funds, and grant funds, including the COPS More '98 Technology grant (\$489,190), the above-mentioned CLETEP grant (\$200,000), and Local Law Enforcement Block Grant (LLEBG) funds from the Bureau of Justice Assistance (\$6,000).

The \$188,122 in CLETEP II funds will augment the equipment component of this project by providing a substantial portion of the funding still needed to purchase the Mobile Data Computers (MDCs) to be installed in all Sheriffs Office patrol vehicles. These MDCs will form the critical link between the officer in the field and the new Sheriffs Office information management system.

It is, therefore, recommended that your Board:

- 1. Adopt the attached resolution accepting and appropriating \$188,122 in unanticipated revenue for the purchase of **MDCs** for the Sheriffs Office patrol vehicles, and
- 2. Authorize the Sheriffs Office to purchase one lot of **MDCs**, the number and price to be determined through the normal County purchasing process, at a cost not to exceed \$188,122.
