SUBJECT: SUBMITTAL OF PROJECT STUDY REPORT FOR
THE AMESTI ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Members of the Board:

The Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission (SCCRTC) at its November 2, 2000, meeting concurred with the California Department of Transportation on a no build alternative for the Proposed Highway 17 Truck Climbing Lane Project. This action makes \$2,000,000 in funds eligible to be reprogrammed at the January 2001 SCCRTC meeting through a public hearing process. The SCCRTC Board members at the November 2000 meeting also indicated that they would give strong consideration to utilizing \$1,500,000 of the STIP funds for the Amesti Road Reconstruction Project when the allocation of such funds is discussed in January 2001. Our department proposes to submit a Project Study Report to the SCCRTC in mid December 2000 to request that \$1,500,000 of the STIP funds be reprogrammed for the Amesti Road Reconstruction Project. The required local match funds of approximately \$200,000 are available in the 2000/2001 Road Fund contingencies. We have attached for your Board's consideration a resolution that authorizes the submittal of the Project Study Report to the SCCRTC to seek the reprogrammed funds for the Amesti Road Reconstruction Project.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Adopt the attached resolution authorizing the submittal of a Project Study Report to request \$1,500,000 in State Transportation Improvement Program funding to be reprogrammed for the Amesti Road Reconstruction Project during the January 2001 SCCRTC public hearing.

- 2.. Direct the Department of Public Works to report back to your Board on or before March 20, 2001, regarding the Arnesti Road Reconstruction Project.



RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF A
PROJECT STUDY REPORT FOR THE
AMESTI ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT TO THE
SANTA CRUZ COUNTY REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Amesti Road was severely damaged as a result of storm events that occurred in 1995 and 1998 and has remained closed indefinitely; and

WHEREAS, Amesti Road is a major arterial roadway in the south county where it previously served as a secondary access to the residents in the area and as a significant emergency route; and

WHEREAS, the County has previously retained IT/EMCOM to perform preliminary engineering work and to develop cost estimates to repair the roadway; and

WHEREAS, the County proposes to utilize \$200, 000 from Road Fund contingencies as a local match for future State Transportation Improvement Program funding and to fund engineering consultant services for the Amesti Road Reconstruction Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the submittal of a Project Study Report for the Amesti Road Reconstruction Project to request \$1,500,000 in State Transportation Improvement Program funds that will be reprogrammed during the January 2001 Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission meeting.
