SUBJECT: INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT LOCAL TASK FORCE


Members of the Board:

In April 1990 your Board established the Santa Cruz County Integrated Waste Management Local Task Force (Task Force) in conformance with requirements of state law. The responsibilities of the Local Task Force, as prescribed by state statutes, are to advise in the preparation, periodic review, and update of the Countywide Integrated Waste Management Plan and its components. These components are the Source Reduction and Recycling element, Household Hazardous Waste element, Non-Disposal Facility element, and Siting element.

The Task Force also provides interagency coordination in the development and implementation of the individual programs of these elements such as recycling, composting, and related public education and information. As the Task Force is formally constituted as a County committee, it is necessary at this time to renew the two-year term of this committee and to re-appoint the existing members of the Task Force.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution extending the termination date of the Santa Cruz County Integrated Waste Management Local Task Force to January 14, 2003 and re-appointing the existing members of the Task Force for terms to expire January 14, 2003.

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 14-99 TO EXTEND THE TERMINATION
DATE OF THE SANTA CRUZ COUNTY INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT
LOCAL TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Cruz has, by Resolution 217-90 established the Santa Cruz County Integrated Waste Management Local Task Force in compliance with the Integrated Waste Management Act of 1989 and;

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Cruz has, by Resolution 14-99, extended the term of the Santa Cruz County Integrated Waste Management Local Task Force to January 14, 2001 and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors does find that the Santa Cruz County Integrated Waste Management Local Task Force will continue to be needed to assist the County of Santa Cruz and the cities within the county in meeting the mandates of the Integrated Waste Management Act of 1989.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz that the term of the Santa Cruz County Integrated Waste Management Local Task Force is hereby extended for a period not to extend two years from the date of adoption of this resolution and that the existing members of the Santa Cruz County Integrated Waste Management Local Task Force be reappointed for terms to expire January 14, 2003.
